If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

**1. Scope of Supply**

**2. Generic**

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- Copy of PAN Card.
- Copy of GSTIN.
- Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

### 3. **Generic**

Experience Criteria: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for 2 years before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the year. In case of bunch bids, the primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

### 4. **Generic**

**Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

### 5. **Generic**

Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

### 6. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

#### 1. **Risk Purchase**

**a)** In the event of failure of the supplier to deliver or dispatch the stores within the stipulated date/period of the supply order or in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order/ contract, ECL shall have the right to purchase the stores from elsewhere after due notice to the defaulting supplier at the risk and cost of the defaulting supplier. The cost as per risk purchase exercise may be recovered from the Earnest Money Deposit/ Security Deposit/ Performance Security of the supplier and/or bills submitted by the supplier against the same contract or any other contract pending in the ECL and/or in any other Subsidiary Companies / CIL.

**b)** Risk purchase action may be initiated as a last resort, under any of the following conditions:

- (i) When the supplier fails to deliver the materials even after extending the delivery period.
- (ii) When the supplier fails to respond to purchaser's request for supply of the materials and fails to provide any genuine and bonafide reason for the delay in supply.
- (iii) When the supplier breaches any of the terms and conditions of the supply order/ contract and as a result fails to execute the order satisfactorily.

2. **Price Fall Clause:** If the contract holder reduces its price or sells or even offers to sell the contracted goods or services following conditions of sale similar to those of the contract, at a price lower than the contract price, to any person or organization during the currency of the contract, the contract price will be

e automatically reduced with effect from that date for all the subsequent supplies under the contract and the contract be amended accordingly.

- i. The currency of contract will mean the period till completion of supply.
- ii. The bidder will be asked to submit a copy of the last (latest) purchase order (bidder may opt to mask the price portion and shall submit an undertaking that prices copy will be submitted on being L1 after opening of Price Bid/Reverse Auction) for the tendered / similar item(s) received by them from any Organization / Ministry / Department of the Govt. of India or Coal India Ltd. and/or its Subsidiaries or other PSU or any other private organization, along with the offer

In case the bidder has not received any purchase order for the tendered / similar item(s) from any Organization / Ministry / Department of the Govt. of India or Coal India Ltd. and/or its Subsidiaries or other PSU or any other private organization, they need to submit a self-certificate as under:

“It is hereby certified that, We..... (Name of the Firm), have not received any order for the tendered / similar item(s) from any Organization / Ministry / Department of the Govt. of India or Coal India Ltd. and / or its Subsidiaries or other PSU or any other Private Organization.”

- iii. It shall be responsibility of the supplier to inform the purchaser of offer to supply / supply of the ordered / similar item(s) at a lower rate to any Organization / Ministry / Department of the Govt. of India or Coal India Ltd. and/or its Subsidiaries or other PSU or any other private organization during the currency of the contract.
- iv. The supplier shall submit a certificate along with the bill(s) as under:-

“I/We certify that there has been no reduction in the sale price of the offered / supplied goods under this contract or similar item(s) and such goods have not been offered/sold by me/ us to any Organization / Ministry / Department of the Govt. of India or Coal India Ltd. and/or its Subsidiaries or other PSU or any other private organization, as the case may be, during the currency of the contract at a price lower than the price charged under the contract.”

3. **LETTER OF BID (LOB):** The bidder shall furnish the Letter of Bid in the format enclosed in **Annexure - A** of the Buyer Uploaded ATC Docs in their company letterhead. The LOB should be signed by an authorized person of the company.
4. **PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG):** The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Guarantee (in the format enclosed as **Annexure - B** of **Buyer Uploaded ATC Docs.**) equivalent to 10% value of the total landed value of the contract including all taxes, duties and other costs and charges, without considering Input Tax Credit.

The performance Bank Guarantee shall be valid for period of **18 (Eighteen) months** from the date of the supply.

The Performance Guarantee shall be in the form of a Bank Guarantee issued by issued/ confirmed from any of the RBI Scheduled Commercial banks in India in the prescribed format on a non-judicial stamp paper.

**The address and other details (including telephone no.) of the controlling officer of the issuing bank should be included in Bank Guarantee**

**Bank Guarantee must be operable and encashable at the Bank's local Branch at Asansol**

The PBG will be submitted through Structured Financial Management System (SFMS). In cases where the supplier does not submit the PBG in time or as per the prescribed format in line with the contract stipulations, the PBG amount will be deducted from the first bill or in case of insufficient amount, from subsequent bill(s) of the supplier till the full PBG amount is deducted. This amount shall be refunded to the supplier upon acceptance of PBG submitted by them.

The release of the Performance Bank guarantee(s) after above indicated period, shall be subject to satisfactory performance of the equipment/ items during the warranty period, no claim pending and fulfilment of all contractual obligations. In the event of breach of a contract / failure of fulfilment of contractual obligations by the supplier, the Performance Bank Guarantee shall be forfeited and encashed / credited to ECL's account.

- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**
