1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating

to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 2. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

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## II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

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Eligibility Criteria for Tap hole tubes:

1. The bidder shall be an Indian manufacturer of single piece tube/sleeve for Tap-hole repairs of Converters (BOF) (Class-I or Class-II local supplier as per Order No. P-45021/2/2017 PP (BEII) of DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce, GOI). The manufacturer shall submit self-attested copies of suitable documents like GST Registration/Business License / ISO certificate or any other Govt. certified document for evidence of bidder's status as manufacturer of single piece tube/sleeve for Tap-hole repairs of Converters (BOF).

Manufacturers, who have successfully supplied similar/better quality single piece tube/sleeve for Tap-hole repairs of Converters (BOF) of capacity 100 T or more, to any of the Indian Govt. organizations, PSUs or Public Limited companies in any one of the last five years ending last day of the month previous to one in which tenders are invited are eligible for this tender. Such parties need to furnish the copies of

i. Three purchase orders each valued not less than Rs.31.489 lakhs

OR

ii. Two purchase orders each valued not less than Rs.41.985 lakhs

OR

iii. Single purchase order not valued less than Rs.62.978 lakhs

**Note: - The above values are without GST.**

Corresponding copies of Supply Invoices/E-Way bill/excise duty gate pass/Completion certificate and performance certificate(s) where the average life is  $\geq 105$  heats from the customer for successful execution of submitted purchase orders.

2. Supporting documents to substantiate the bidders as manufacturers are to be submitted. The financial turnover in any one of the last 3 financial years ending on 31st March of the previous financial year should be minimum Rs. 104.96 Lakhs. It is to be supported by copies of audited P&L accounts & balance sheets. The turnover certificate and the audited Profit and Loss account certified by the CA member to be submitted by tenderer in support of the turnover and it must contain Unique Document Identification Number(UDIN).

A relaxation of 15% in Financial Turnover will be provided in the eligibility criteria for MSEs who are eligible for preference and Start-ups that are recognized by Department for Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT).

However both MSE and Start-ups shall have to meet eligibility conditions for quality & technical specifications/requirement.

3. Vendors who have successfully supplied this item to Bhilai Steel Plant, in any of the last five preceding years, onwards previously shall be considered eligible for this tender, and they need not submit any of the documents, as mentioned in point #1. However, they have to submit the documents as mentioned in point #2.

4. All documents should be self-attested.

### **III. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS :**

1. Plant operational parameters of the converters (BOF) of SMS-2, BSP:

i) Temperature of steel bath is between 1650°C to 1720 °C.

ii) Duration of tapping is  $\geq 4$  Minutes.

2. Scope of Supply & Application:

i) Supply of Tubes, as per indicated Tap hole tube Drawing No.: RED-II-LD-2005-02/R2.

ii) Supply of Filler Mass as per requirement (minimum 600 Kg per tube is mandatory).

iii) Placement of the tube in the Tap-Hole & filling the gap (approx. 40mm) between the outer of tube and inner of drilled hole by supplied filler mass, through Gunning/Spraying/filling etc., to be done by the supplier's own machine and manpower. BSP will provide electricity, water, compressed air etc. Vendor need to keep gunning machines ready (advisable to keep 2 machine: 1 operation + 1 standby in ready condition).

iv) Application activities of tube fixing is a round the clock job and may be in any of the converter. Accordingly, supplier is to execute tube fixing as per requirement of the shop round the clock, (inclusive of Sundays & Holidays).

3. Payment Terms: Only 100% taxes & duties as applicable shall be paid against material receipt note (GRN) supported by GC/WC and balance payment for material and application shall be made on issuance of monthly performance certificate by DGM(O)/GM(O) of Converter Shop.

4. Performance guarantee & bonus penalty clause:

a. Unit Cost: Ex-works cost of 1 Tube (inclusive of filler mass).

b. Supplied Tube (along with filler Mass), should bear a minimum Heat Guarantee of 150 heats per tube.

c. Payment will be on performance basis irrespective of tube size and quantity of filler mass applied, and payment will be as follows:

i) Payment for life achieved  $\geq 150$  heats and  $\leq 180$  heats: The formula for the payment calculation will be:

• Payment = Unit Cost X Actual Life/150

• For e.g. if Actual life achieved is 160 heat than Payment = Unit Cost X 160/150

ii) Ceiling on Bonus Payment at 180 heats: For life, achieved more than 180 heats, no additional bonus shall be paid i.e. bonus payment will be limited to 180 heats.

(iii) Payment for life achieved  $< 150$  and  $\geq 105$  heats: The payment shall be made based on the following formula:

• Payment = Unit Cost X (Actual Life/150) X (Actual Life/150)

• For e.g. if Actual life achieved is 110 heats than

Payment = Unit Cost X (110 / 150) X (110 /150)

iv) No Payment Clause: No payment for tube life achieved < 105 heats due to Tap hole tube refractory failure. However, taxes, duties & freight will be paid as per PO.

5. Last tube of the Converter-lining campaign, whereby converter has been put down for relining (due to maturity or any other reason) will be fully paid in case the tube life is <150 heats. In such cases the tube will be assumed to have given a life of 150 heats. In cases where the tube has given more than 150 heats, payment will be on actual heat life. (Maximum up to 180 heats)

6. In case of Metal leakage between 105 and 150 heats (both inclusive) due to poor quality of tap hole tube refractory, payment will be made assuming that the tube has matured at life of 105 heats. If the leakage occurs above desired heat guarantee, payment shall be made assuming that the tube has matured at the life of 150 heats. In case of jam cleaning surrounding tap hole area, if any breakage occurs - case may be considered for normal maturity tube life i.e. 150 heats against operational reason.

7. After tap hole drilling by BSP, converter will be given for fixing of tap hole tube and associated activities, which is to be done by supplier in stipulated time.

8. Individual quantities of different tube-lengths may be re-adjusted depending on the actual consumption and requirement. Keeping the overall dimensions of the tube (except lengths) same, bore-dia of the tube may be changed with mutual agreement, to suit the operational requirements.

9. Performance: The performance would be monitored and performance report (each tap hole tube) will be issued by GM(O)/DGM(O) of Conv. Shop, SMS-2 on monthly basis and the same shall be sent to vendor, Purchase, and Finance & Stores for release of necessary payment/recovery/ supplementary payment to the supplier. The performance certificate issued by shop will be treated as final and no request for review will be entertained.

10. BSP reserves the right to suspend/cancel/short close/divert the order at the risk and cost of the party, if the party's performance is consistently poor.

11. Bidder has to quote for full tendered quantity.

12. For free supply of the filler mass, party shall raise a separate challan cum invoice for no payment. However, BSP may avail GST credit, against relevant documents to be submitted by the vendors, and reimburse the same to the vendors.

13. Monthly delivery schedule shall be 15 tubes per month or as per the requirement of the shop. Minimum 06 Nos. of the item must always be available at BSP stores. If the stock is not maintained and due to this shop performance is adversely affected, a penalty of Rs. 25000 per occurrence shall be levied on the party.

14. Order shall be placed with a condition that "BSP reserve the right to increase order quantity by 25% within the delivery period. Increase in order quantity can be done within delivery period. However, for additional quantity BSP may extend delivery period suitably.

15. Price evaluation will be done on overall (i.e. including all items and application) L-1 basis only.

If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
