

### Software Features:

1. There must be direct integration with the attendance machine, allowing users to register through the software.
2. Real-time synchronization of logs from multiple attendance machines across various locations with integrated facial recognition, fingerprint, and RFID card.
3. Enable face and fingerprint registration directly from centrally located software, accessible from multiple attendance machines located on various locations, streamlining the process for convenient user registration across the network.
4. Transfer of data for multiple employees to a single attendance machine, as well as the transfer of data for a single or employees to multiple attendance machines.
5. Facilitate the assignment of multiple shifts effortlessly within the system, allowing for flexible scheduling and seamless management of workforce shifts.
6. Solution that integrates with attendance machines of multilocation, allowing multiple devices to be managed from one place, making it easy to track Realtime attendance on a single dashboard.
7. Implement Aadhar-based employee registration, utilizing Aadhar verification alongside a comprehensive system for verifying all other legal documents, ensuring compliance and authenticity in the registration process.
8. Store attendance times locally on attendance machines and the mobile app when disconnected from the centralized software, seamlessly transmitting data once the connection is re-established, ensuring no interruption in attendance tracking.
9. Customizing any additional features or reports we may require tailoring the system to our specific needs.

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10. The software must be web-enabled and accessible throughout the network via a URL, with user rights assigned based on the university's requirements with multiple login according to the user rights.

#### **Terms & Conditions:**

1. The bidder must be ISO 9001:2015 certified company with the software as a service category.
2. The bidder must enclose at least three order copies for similar projects, along with their successful installation reports. At least one of these orders must cover a minimum of 4,000 users' attendance.
3. The bidder must deploy a reliable and accurate attendance tracking system including hardware & software that meets the university's specific needs and requirements as per the mentioned hardware and software features.
4. The Attendance Machines will be deployed on the university premises. This system will facilitate users in marking their attendance and provide day-to-day management insights. Additionally, any changes or modifications in employee enrollment.
5. It is imperative to ensure comprehensive monitoring of all areas where attendance machines are deployed. To achieve this, CCTV surveillance will be implemented, or the attendance machines must have the capability to provide a feed to any connected Network Video Recorder (NVR) as a CCTV camera. Additionally, the recorded feed should be stored in the connected NVR for approximately 7-8 days.
6. The primary enrolment process for users, involving biometric, face, finger, and other credentials, will be conducted by the bidder. This enrolment can take place either on-site or through an online mode, based on the specific requirements of the university.
7. The bidder will be responsible for configuring the customized reports as required by the university administration in the Attendance System Software. They will ensure that the software is provisioned with the necessary functionalities to generate the specified customized reports according to the university's needs.
8. The bidder will conduct training sessions for the Nodal or authorized person and their dedicated team of clerks from the university administration. The training will cover all aspects of using the time attendance system effectively, ensuring that the university staff is well-equipped to utilize the system to its full potential.
9. For the software installation, the provision of a dedicated server will be part of the bidder's scope. Bidder will be responsible for setting up and maintaining the dedicated server to ensure the smooth functioning of the Attendance System. This includes ensuring the server's reliability, security, and performance to support the efficient operation of the Attendance System on the university premises.
10. The Call Centre/Help-desk services will be available from Monday to Saturday, operating between 10:00 AM and 05:00 PM. During this period, there will be a 30-minute lunch break. Bidder must provide the details on their letter head.
11. A minimum of 60 attendance machines should be deployed at specific locations within the university, with the flexibility to increase or decrease the number by up to 10-15 based on requirements.


#### **Support from University administration:**



1. The university administration allowed to connect the network connectivity for all attendance machines and the server from existing network. This integration with the university's existing network infrastructure ensures seamless communication and data sharing between the attendance machines and the central server. It facilitates efficient data management and enhances the overall functionality of the attendance system.
2. Any connectivity issues related to the university administration's existing network shall be the responsibility of the university administration itself and will not be within the scope of services provided by the service provider. The service provider's responsibility primarily lies in ensuring the proper functioning and maintenance of the attendance system, while the university administration is accountable for the stability and upkeep of their network infrastructure.
3. The university administration will designate a Nodal Officer/Administrator during the installation of the attendance system on the university premises. This Nodal Officer/Administrator should be accompanied by a dedicated team of clerks, as required, to manage various aspects of the attendance system efficiently. Their responsibilities include:
  - i) Enrolment Management: Handling changes or modifications in employee enrolment, including biometric, face, finger, and other credentials.
  - ii) Time Schedule Management: Managing changes or modifications in employee time schedules as per the hospital's requirements.
  - iii) Attendance Discrepancy Management: Addressing and correcting any discrepancies, exceptions, or errors in attendance marking by users.
  - iv) User Requests Handling: Assisting users with any requests related to the attendance system.
  - v) Leave Request Management: Processing and managing leave requests submitted by users.
  - vi) Report Generation: Generating periodic reports as required by the university administration.

Having a dedicated team of clerks under the Nodal Officer/Administrator's supervision ensures smooth and efficient management of the attendance system, enabling seamless operations and data accuracy.

4. The user/administrator rights management, login credentials, and access to the Time Attendance System Server, Client PCs, and Time Attendance Machines through passwords/authentication shall be kept under the custody and responsibility of the Nodal Officer/Administrator or any other designated authority of the University Administration. This measure is crucial for ensuring the security, safety, and privacy of the system and preventing any unauthorized breach of data. By maintaining strict control over user access and login credentials, the university administration can effectively safeguard sensitive information and maintain the integrity of the Time Attendance System.
5. The University Administration will be responsible for arranging the provision and issue of APIs (Application Programming Interfaces) and any necessary support for integration as and when required. APIs are essential for integrating the Time Attendance System with other applications or systems used by the hospital. By

providing APIs and integration support, the University Administration enables seamless data exchange and interoperability between different systems, enhancing the overall efficiency and functionality of the Time Attendance System.

6. The University Administration will be responsible for providing the necessary power source for the Time Attendance System. This includes ensuring a stable and reliable power supply to all attendance machines, servers, and any other associated equipment to ensure uninterrupted operation of the system. A consistent power source is crucial for the smooth functioning of the Time Attendance System and to avoid any disruptions in attendance tracking and data management.
7. The University Administration bears the cost of repair/replacement for any equipment damage due to accidents, miscreants, theft, fire, or natural mishaps.

15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

**All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.**

**For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.**

**The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:**

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove;**

and

- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**
