If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
6. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
7. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
8. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating

to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 9. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

10. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

11. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.

1. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- Copy of PAN Card.
- Copy of GSTIN.
- Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

2. Generic

Non return of Hard Disk: As per Buyer organization's Security Policy, Faulty Hard Disk of Servers/Desktop Computers/ Laptops etc. will not be returned back to the OEM/supplier against warranty replacement.

3. Generic

Malicious Code Certificate:

The seller should upload following certificate in the bid:-

(a) This is to certify that the Hardware and the Software being offered, as part of the contract, does not contain Embedded Malicious code that would activate procedures to :-

- Inhibit the desires and designed function of the equipment.
- Cause physical damage to the user or equipment during the exploitation.
- Tap information resident or transient in the equipment/network.

(b) The firm will be considered to be in breach of the procurement contract, in case physical damage, loss of information or infringements related to copyright and Intellectual Property Right (IPRs) are caused due to activation of any such malicious code in embedded software.

4. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

5. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 3 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

1 Prohibition of Chinese - Origin Components in Laptop. Laptop and all its subsystems components, and software do not contain any parts, modules firmware, or software of Chinese origin or manufacture, either directly or through third - party integration, The vendor shall be held liable for any breach of this clause and discovery of any such content shall lead to immediate rejection of the equipment and imposition of penalties as deemed appropriate by the procuring authority.

2. Liquidated Damages. In the event of the Seller's failure to submit the Bonds, Guarantees and Documents, supply the stores / goods etc as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The BUYER may also deduct from the SELLER as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed / undelivered stores / services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed stores

3. Eligibility Criteria for Vendors. "Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) as per article 1.4 14 Defence Procurement Manual 2009 or Permanent registered authorized distributors of OEM may only apply. For permanent registered distributors, a copy of agreement certificate duly indicating registration number or permanent authorized dealership is mandatory to be enclosed.

4. Delivery Location. Goods must be delivered to the designated site as specified by the buyer, with all logistics, transportation, and insurance costs borne by the supplier. Location of delivery will be Mamun Cantt, Pathankot district of Punjab.

5. National Security. Govt of India /Indian Army reserves the right to disqualify any vendor should it be so necessary at any stage, on grounds of National Security.

6. Demurrage Charges. In case the rejected items are not lifted by the firm within 48 hrs, demurrage charges at the rate of 0.5% of total contract value will be charged per day. In case the items are not lifted within a month, the same will be destroyed by a station board of officers and no claim will be admitted.

7. Franking Clause. The following Franking clause will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder:-

(a) Franking Clause in the case of Acceptance of Goods. "The fact that the goods have been inspected after the delivery period and passed by the Inspecting Officer will not have the effect of keeping the contract alive. The goods are being passed without prejudice to the rights of the Buyer under the terms and conditions of the contract".

(b) Franking Clause in the case of Rejection of Goods. "The fact that the goods have been inspected after the delivery period and rejected by the Inspecting Officer will not bind the Buyer in any manner. The goods are being rejected without prejudice to the rights of the Buyer under the terms and conditions of the contract."

8. Fall Clause. The following Fall clause will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder:-

(a) The price charged for the stores supplied under the contract by the Seller shall in no event exceed the lowest prices at which the Seller sells the stores or offer to sell stores of identical description to any persons/ Organizations including the purchaser or any department of the Central government or any Department of the State government or any statutory undertaking of the Central or State government as the case may be during the period till performance of all Supply Orders placed during the currency of the rate contract is completed.

(b) If at any time, during the said period the Seller reduces the sale price, sells or offer to sell such stores to any person / organization including the Buyer or any Dept, of Central Govt or any Department of the State Government or any Statutory undertaking of the Central or State Government as the case may be at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract, he shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the Director general of supplies and Disposals and the price payable under the contract for the stores of such reduction of sale or offer of the sale shall stand correspondingly reduced. The above stipulation will, however, not apply to:-

(i) Exports by the Seller.

(ii) Sale of goods as original equipment at price lower than the prices charged for normal replacement.

(iii) Sale of goods such as drugs which have expiry dates.

(iv) Sale of goods at lower price on or after the date of completion of sale/placement of the order of goods by the authority concerned under the existing or previous Rate Contracts as also under any previous contracts entered into with the Central or State Govt. Departments, including their undertakings excluding joint sector companies and/or private parties and bodies.

(c) The Seller shall furnish the following certificate to the Paying Authority along with each bill for payment for supplies made against the rate contract - "We certify that there has been no reduction in sale price of the stores of description identical to the stores supplied to the Government under the contract herein and such stores have not been offered/sold by me/us to any person / organization including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any Department of a state Government or any Statutory Undertaking of the Central or state Government as the case may be upto the date of bill/the date of completion of supplies against all supply orders placed during the currency of the Rate Contract at price lower than the price charged to the government under the contract except for quantity of stores categories under sub-clauses (i), (ii) and (iii) of Sub-Para (b) above details of which are given below -".

9. Tolerance Clause. To take care of any change in the requirement during the period starting from issue of bid till placement of the contract, buyer reserve the right to increase or decrease the quantity of the required goods upto 25% without any change in the terms & conditions and prices quoted by the seller.

10. Option Clause. The contract will have an Option Clause, where in the Buyer can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms and conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within the currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract. It will be entirely the discretion of the buyer to exercise this option or not.

11. Warranty. The following Warranty will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder:

(a) The Seller warrants that the Laptop including battery equipment's supplied under the contract conform to technical specifications prescribed and shall perform according to the said technical specifications.

(b) The Seller warrants for a period of 36 Months from the date of acceptance of Laptop including battery equipment by Joint Receipt Inspection or date of installation and commissioning, whichever is later, that the goods/stores supplied under the contract and each component used in the manufacture thereof shall be free from all types of defects/failures.

(c) If within the period of warranty, the goods are reported by the Buyer to have failed to perform as per the specifications, the Seller shall either replace or rectify the same free of charge, within a maximum period of 05 days of notification of such defect received by the Seller, provided that the goods are used and maintained by the Buyer as per instructions contained in the Operating Manual. Warranty of the equipment would be extended by such duration of downtime. Record of the down time would be maintained by the us

er in the logbook. Spares required for warranty repairs shall be provided free of cost by the Seller. The Seller also undertakes to diagnose, test, adjust, calibrate and repair/replace the goods/equipment arising due to accidents by neglect or misuse by the operator or damage due to transportation of the goods during the warranty period, at the cost mutually agreed to between the Buyer and the Seller.

(d) The Seller also warrants that necessary service and repair back up during the warranty period of the equipment shall be provided by the Seller and he will ensure that the downtime is within 2 Weeks of the warranty period.

(e) The Seller shall associate technical personnel of the Maintenance agency and Quality Assurance Agency of the Buyer during warranty repair and shall also provide the details of complete defects, reasons and remedial actions for defects.

(f) The seller warrants that essential components and spares required for system maintenance will be kept on site and that all repairs will be carried out on site. Permission in writing will be sought by the seller in case any item has to be moved out from the installation site for any repairs.

(g) If a particular equipment/goods fails frequently and/or, the cumulative down time exceeds 2 Weeks of the warranty period, the complete equipment shall be replaced free of cost by the Seller within a stipulated period of 60 days of receipt of the notification from the Buyer. Warranty of the replaced equipment would start from the date of acceptance after Joint Receipt Inspection by the Buyer/date of installation and commissioning whichever is later.

(h) In case the complete delivery of Engineering Support Package is delayed beyond the period stipulated in this contract, the Seller undertakes that the warranty period for the goods/stores shall be extended to that extent.

Repair and Replacement. In case of a defect, the Supplier must respond within 48 hours of receiving notification from the Buyer and either repair or replace the defective part within 5 days.

12. Warranty Coverage. The warranty shall cover:-

- (a) Manufacturing defects, including material defects and faulty workmanship.
- (b) Defects in design or functionality that prevent the equipment from operating as intended.
- (c) Repair or replacement of defective components, at no cost to the buyer.

13. Exclusions from Warranty. The warranty does not cover:-

- (a) Damage caused by misuse, unauthorized alterations, improper installation, or non-compliance with the operating instructions.
- (b) Accidental damage, negligence, or vandalism.

14. Warranty Extension. The warranty period shall be extended for the period during which the product was out of operation due to warranty-related repairs.

15. Timely servicing/rectification of defects during warranty period. After having been notified of the defects/servicing requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service/Rectification within 05 Days depending upon the nature of defect and extent of Repair/Replacement/Intervention required. Seller can deposit the penalty with the Buyer directly else the Buyer shall have a right to recover all such penalty amount from the Performance Security (PBG). Cumulative Penalty can not exceed 10% of the total contract value after which the Buyer shall have the right to get the service/rectification done from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the seller besides forfeiture of PBG. Seller shall be liable to reimburse the cost of such service rectification to the buyer.

16. Life Certificate of the Eqpt. A "Life Certificate of the equipment duly certified by the OEM / vendor to be submitted along with the bids," certifying at least two years of product service life from the date of supply.

17. Force Majeure Clause.

(a) Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non performance of any of its obligations (except for failure to pay any sum which has become due on account of receipt of goods under the provisions of the present contract), if the non-performance results from such Force Majeure circumstances a

s Flood, Fire, Earth Quake and other acts of God as well as War, Military operation, adverse internal security situation, blockade, Acts or Actions of State Authorities or any other circumstances beyond the parties control that have arisen after the conclusion of the present contract.

(b) In such circumstances the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the present contract is extended correspondingly for the period of time of action of these circumstances and their consequences.

(c) The party for which it becomes impossible to meet obligations under this contract due to Force Majeure conditions, is to notify in written form the other party of the beginning and cessation of the above circumstances immediately, but in any case not later than 10 (Ten) days from the moment of their beginning.

(d) Certificate of a Chamber of Commerce (Commerce and Industry) or other competent authority or organization of the respective country shall be a sufficient proof of commencement and cessation of the above circumstances.

18. Amendments. No provision of present Contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present Contract.

19. Payment Plan. Payment will be made in single phase.

20. Product Support. The following Product Support clause will form part of the contract placed on successful bidder:-

(a) The Seller agrees to provide Product Support for the stores, assemblies/ sub-assemblies, fitment items and consumables, sub contracted from other agencies/manufactured by the seller for a minimum period of one year including three years of warranty period and AMC post the warranty period after the delivery of Laptop.

(b) In the event of obsolescence during the above mentioned period of product support in respect of any component or sub system, mutual consultation between the Seller and Buyer will be undertaken to arrive at an acceptable solution including additional cost, if any.

21. Payment Terms.
