If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 2. 4. 7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.
8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
9. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
  2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
  3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.
10. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

### 2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

**\*Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC for Hiring Junior and Senior Executives.**

1. The bidder should have its registered/branch office at Mizoram (Aizawl) and must remain in at Mizoram (Aizawl) during currency of the contract.
2. The Bidder must be registered with the Income Tax, Goods and service Tax and also registered under the Labour laws and other authorities as applicable.
3. The bidder must be registered with at concern State GST Department. Copy of GST registration shall be furnished with bid.
4. Attending pre-bid meeting on scheduled date and time is mandatory. An attendance certificate shall be issued by this office to the participating bidder(s), which must be submitted along with the bid as proof of participation.
5. The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceeding. The bidder should also not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload valid undertaking to this effect with bid.
6. The Bidder should not be blacklisted during last 5 years by any Govt. Department (Central/State/PSU). Bidder to upload valid undertaking to this effect with bid.
7. Service Provider is required to pay Salaries/Wages of contractual staff (Junior/Senior Executive) deployed at this office location first i.e. on their own and then claim payment from this office along with all statutory documents as well as the bank statement of payment done to contractual staff.
8. The service provider shall pay salary/wages to the manpower deployed before 10<sup>th</sup> of every month.
9. The Service Provider shall raise invoice/bill on monthly basis.
10. No advance payment will be made against this contract by this office to service provider.
11. In the event that the Service Provider fails to deploy requisite manpower within T+2 days, the Service Provider shall be liable to pay a penalty of Rs. 500/- per day per resource of delay, subject to a maximum of 10% of the total contract value.
12. Such penalties, if so imposed, shall be deducted from any amounts payable to the Service Provider under this contract or, if no such amounts are due, shall be paid by the Service Provider within 15 days of receiving a written demand from this office.
13. The imposition of such penalties, if so, shall not prevent this office from pursuing other remedies available under this contract, including termination of the contract and forfeit of Performance Bank Guarantee.
14. If contract premature cancelled/terminated by this office, payment will be released on pro-rata basis subject to LD clauses, if any, and performance of service provider.
15. The Office reserve rights to increase or decrease the number of contractual manpower required at its discretion during the currency of the contract.

Service provider is bounded to accept the same.

16. The Service provider shall not assign the contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of this office.
17. The Office reserve rights to cancel/terminate the contract by giving one-month notice to service provider.
18. No charges, by whatever name, including registration charges will be charged from the contractual manpower. It is expected that such charges are included in the service charges which is the basis of the financial bid. In case at any point of time it comes to the notice of the Department that the service provider: -
  - (a) Has charged/taken any share from the salary/wages of the contractual manpower.
  - (b) Has not made the payment of salary to the staff within the stipulated time.
  - (c) Has not deposited statutory dues, if any etc.
  - (d) Has not fulfilled any other condition mentioned in the contract document.

The Department will deduct such amount from PBG or amount payable to the service provider and may also exercise the right to cancel the contract and may initiate the proceedings to blacklist the vendor on GeM Portal.

19. The normal office timing/General shift shall be 09:30 AM to 06:00 PM with half an hour lunch break from 01:30 PM to 02:00 PM. However, timing/shift may be changed at the discretion of the office. In case of urgency, the manpower can be deployed beyond normal duty hours/on holiday. The manpower will be entitled to 12 days casual leaves per year on prorata basis. Beyond specified leaves as applicable, leave will be treated as leave without pay (LWP) for which necessary deduction will be made by this office in the billed amount, if no replacement provided.
20. The manpower provided by the Service Provider shall not be deemed employees of this office hence the compliance of the applicable acts/laws will be the sole responsibility of the service provider.
21. The Service provider should invariably provide ID Cards to its workforce deployed at this office for allowing entry in the office premises.
22. In case of loss of property of the organization caused by the negligence of the employee of the service provider, the service provider will be held responsible for making good to the said losses.
23. The police verification reports must be submitted by the service provider for all personnel provided.
24. In case of any temporary shortage, substitute should be provided by the service provider.
25. No medical facilities, reimbursement, or any form of medical claims in res

pect of the manpower provided by the service provider shall be entertained by this office. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Service provider to ensure that its deployed manpower are covered under appropriate medical facilities/insurance at its own cost.

26. The Service Provider shall provide a panel of suitable candidates, from which this office will screen/interview and select the manpower to be deployed

27. This office reserves the right to require the Service Provider to replace any manpower deployed in case of non-performance, unsatisfactory delivery of services, or under any other exceptional case.

28. The successful agency should deposit Performance Bank Guarantee @ 5% of total contract amount valid for initial 26 months within 07 days from the date of award of the contract. The PBG must remain valid during currency of contract and extended period of contract, if any.

29. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificate/undertaking/document sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum, if any.

#### अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
