If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
6. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
7. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
8. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 9. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

10. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

11. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

B. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION OF PRECAST BOX CULVERT

- Design, Manufacture & Supply** of factory-made (wet cast) high strength precast reinforced cement concrete box culverts of **size 2000 (W) x 1500 (D)** having **length 1000mm**, boxes steam cured in a controlled environment and manufactured by using high performance self-compacting concrete of **M- 50** grade using Fe 500 / 550 D grade TMT steel reinforcement bar. Design should conform to IRC 122-2017/BIS standards, furthermore taking into consideration expected handling and erection stresses etc. Any international guideline such as AASHTO, FHWA (Accelerated Bridge construction Guidelines) Japan and EURO codes may be followed in case of any gap in IRC/BIS standard and guideline. The design of the box culvert should be vetted/proof checked by IIT/NIT, Certificate of NIT shall be attached with Tender document. The precast culvert should be designed considering super imposed dead load, live load including dynamic impact, tractive and braking forces and earth pressure as per IRC:6-2017. Class AA loading or Class 70R Load live load should be considered (whichever is higher) for design. Box culvert shall have interlocking plug-socket

arrangement.

2. **Supply and Providing accessory:** Loading and transporting of precast concrete box culverts shall be done with care. Handling shall be such as to avoid impact. Rubber gasket required to ensure water-tight character and for jointing of each segment flange-bolt connection with 12 mm diameter, 50 mm length Grade-8.8 high tensile bolts with zinc coating and round washer or equivalent nut-bolt connection will be supplied as part of the Box culvert. Technical assistance in form of technical presentation for installation procedure of product and/or one-time visit at site by technical team member of the manufacturer and supplier.
3. **Quality Assurance:** The product shall be manufactured from standard and tested raw materials including cement, fine aggregate, coarse aggregate, concrete and reinforcement. The water used for manufacturing of concrete should be potable water with TDS value not more than 300 ppm. The product shall be steam cured in the controlled environment for better quality control with a temperature control of 45 ± 2 Deg. Centigrade to $65, \pm 2$ Deg. Centigrade. The factory-made precast products shall be subject to strict quality control and assurance process by the manufacturer and approved by quality assurance personnel. The product must have reinforcement as per design drawings. The product should be handled mechanically at site. The product shall have in-built inserts at optimized locations for handling/transportation.
4. **Precast manufacturer and supplier specification:** Precast RCC component manufacturer and supplier shall have national and international reputation based on experience and shall be certified for ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and ISO 45001 for design, manufacture and dispatch of products. The precast manufacturer shall have in house NABL approved quality control laboratory. The precast factory shall have minimum facility of fully automatic, RMC plant for better quality, arrangements for steam curing, mechanical handling of concrete and pre-cast components, bar bending machines, stacking yard, in house design team and RO plant for water to be used for manufacturing.

5.Mode of measurement: Rate of precast units shall be for unit of one running meter. Rate includes all cost of material, labour charges at plant, cost of reinforcement, formwork and lifting accessories and direct and indirect overheads. Rate shall also include technical assistance in form of technical presentation for installation procedure of product and/or one-time visit at site by technical team member of the manufacturer and supplier.

6. Tolerance:

Finished segment tolerances should not exceed the following:

C. Additional Terms & Conditions

1. The bidder should have experience of supplying to any Central/ State Govt. Organization / PSU for 3 years before the bid opening date for any goods. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied similar works in the last three years to a

ny central/state govt. org.

Bidder should have successfully completed or substantially completed project of supply of precast lined drain in last 3 years for

- a) Three similar of works costing not less than 40% of estimated cost of work or
- b) Two similar works costing not less than 50% of estimated cost of works. or
- c) One similar works costing not less than 80% of estimated cost of works.

Similar Works Means - Supply of Precastline drain, precast box culvert, precast wall etc.

(Supporting Certificates and Documents must be uploaded with Bid)

Substantially completed works means those works which are completed at least 90% on the date of submission of Bid.

2. **The design of product should be vetted/proof checked by IIT/NIT, certificate of NIT shall be attached with the Tender document**
3. The manufacturer must have and certified for ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and ISO 45001 for the product.
4. The manufacturer should have associated NABL approved QC laboratory to ensure consistent quality of precast product. NABL Certificates to be enclosed with submission of Bid.
5. Manufacturer should have in house Quality Control team. Degree and Adhaar of team engineers are required.
6. The bidder should have done similar work at high altitude.
7. Bidder must have working capital Limit / Financial Limit from bank at least 10% of the Bid Value.
8. **Tenderer must have below requisite Equipments, Plants and Vehicles in good working condition**
 - a) Steam Curing Plant :01Nos
 - b) Concrete Batch Mix Plant. :01Nos
 - c) Trailer/Dumper/Tipper/Truck :04Nos
 - d) Hydra machine :01Nos

Note: - Bidder should own/hire critical VEP as per specific requirement of the work as decided/ specified by the buyer

9. The Bidder shall ensure that their Precast lined drain, Precast culvert and Precast wall meet the Technical specification and qualitative parameters as per IRC code and IS standard.
10. L-1 Bidder should provide test result for Cement, Aggregate, steel and sand before supply of goods.
11. Bidder should mention the brand name of Cement and steel to be used for making of RCC Lined drain during uploading of Bid documents.

12. TAXES ETC

The Quoted amount shall inter-alia be deemed to be inclusive of all taxes, viz Work Contract Tax, terminal taxes, toll taxes, Royalty, Octroi, GST, labour welfare cess or any other taxes and the like levies payable under the respective existing States etc. No claim on account of any taxes will be payable to contractor whatsoever.

13. RATE QUOTED

Rates quoted are in one running meter. Rates shall be deemed to include the provisions for all materials, stores, labour, process, operations, and requirements detailed in specifications. The rate quoted shall also include loading and transportation of materials required at Leh for completing the work.

14. Products should be Made in India according to GeM policy. Certificate should be uploaded with technical bid.

15. Only OEM/authorized representative will be allowed to participate in the bid to ensure quality. Authorized representative should give bid specific authorization from OEM.

16. Damage incurred while loading/unloading to precast item will not be accepted in any cost. Hook marks to be avoided

(17) **Performance Undertakings** :The Seller shall submit following undertaking that :-
