1. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 4. ##### 1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

**ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ANDAMAN COLLEGE CANTEEN, CHAK KARGAON, SRI VIJAYA PURAM**

1. The terms and conditions of the bid may be uploaded in GeM Portal with acceptance on the bidders letter head duly signed and sealed from Point No. 2 to 52. Failing which bidder's participation will be rejected.
2. The bidder may quote the, self-calculated total amount in the financial bid for all **27 (Twenty seven)** items as mentioned in the Menu list. If any bidder quotes in respect of the estimated amount in the financial bid will be rejected.
3. The office of the service provider must be located in the state of the consignee. (Document evidence is GST (35) code, Andaman & Nicobar Islands required). Failing which, the bidder's participation will be rejected.
4. FSSAI (Registration Certificate)/Food License must be uploaded as an ADDITIONAL DOCUMENT, failing which the bidder's participation will be rejected.
5. The bidder shall upload PAN/GST as an ADDITIONAL DOCUMENT; if not, the bidder's participation will be rejected.
6. The successful bidder shall pay electricity charges during the contract period, and the receipt of the same may be handed over to the office.
7. MENU ITEMS on their letterhead with seal may be uploaded as ADDITIONAL DOCUMENT; failing which, the bidder's participation will be rejected.
8. The canteen timing will be from 8.00 AM to 4.00 PM.
9. The bidder must fill the specifications column according to the bid requirement; failing which bidder's participation will be rejected
10. The successful bidder shall pay Monthly Rent @ ₹ 5,000/- (Rupees: Five thousand only) per month during the contract period (12 Months)
11. Penalty:-
  - i) The Penalty on rental charges will be levy ₹ 500/- in the first month, ₹ 1000/- for the second month and ₹ 3000/- for third month. Failing which, the contract will be terminated, and PG will be forfeited.
  - ii) The Penalty for poor quality of food supply will be levy ₹ 5000/- in the first instance, Rs 10000/- for the second instance, and ₹ 15000/- will be levy in the final instance. Such practice continues even after repeated request the contract will be terminated , forfeiting the concerned PG and also blacklisting the firm.
12. The monthly rent should be submitted in the form of a **Demand Draft/Bankers' Cheque** only by the contractor to the Principal, ANCOL Office.
13. **Best Price on Fixed Menu Rate Model** : In this service, the buyer asks the service provider to quote the rate in INR for the "total menu cost" as mentioned in the bid document. The bidder can quote any rate higher or lower than the estimated "total menu cost" indicated by the buyer. The service provider quoting the minimum "total menu cost", is selected for the award of this service. Once the **L1 service provider is selected**, the % of total menu cost above/ below the are equally multiplied by the menu items to arrive at the individual menu item rate, keeping the "**total menu cost**" within the quoted rates

14. Contractor must display the approved selling price of items in the canteen in a conspicuous place of canteen
15. The contractor shall keep open the canteen on all working days except Sundays, holidays, etc. The total working days of the canteen shall be around 250 days during the contract period. However, the Competent Authority may direct the service provider/ contractor to keep the canteen on such holidays by giving prior notice.
16. Usage of disposable glass/ plates made of plastic materials, thermocol, is prohibited.
17. Clean filtered drinking water will have to be provided free of cost to the customers.
18. The ANCOL Canteen committee shall inspect the canteen premises weekly/fortnightly for hygiene conditions and quality of serving food items, etc., if the committee finds negligence or improper manner, the contract shall be cancelled.
19. Cooking Gas charges shall be provided by the service provider
20. Basic furniture shall be provided by the service provider
21. Cooking equipment shall be provided by the service provider
22. Essential crockery shall be provided by the service provider
23. Canteen staff shall be provided by the service provider
24. Uniform for canteen staff shall be provided by the service provider
25. Display shelf shall be provided by the service provider
26. Sale of cigarettes, Alcohol, tobacco products, and pan items is not permitted in the college canteen
27. Usage of the LPG burner stove for cooking is permitted. However, usage of a kerosene burner stove or any other conventional type etc., is strictly prohibited
28. Electric Induction Stove & Electric Kettle is strictly prohibited.
29. Junk food is strictly prohibited
30. The Canteen staff should wear a clean apron and suitable gloves while cooking and serving
31. The sweeping and cleaning works are to be carried out as and when required to keep the canteen hygienically clean at least twice a day
32. Periodical cleaning of water storage tanks, etc. at least once a month or as and when required to provide safe drinking water to the users
33. The antecedents of staff deployed by the contractor under this contract should be duly verified by the Police authorities and shall be submitted to this office for record
34. The workers of the contractor should not be below the age of 18 years and not above the age of 60 years as on the date of the contract is effective
35. The contract should ensure payment of his workers as per the minimum wages as notified by the Andaman & Nicobar Administration from time to time
36. The contractor will ensure all safety measures, including fire safety

37. The contractor would be bound to replace such workers whose conduct and service are not found satisfactory by the Canteen Committee/College Administration
38. Periodical medical examination of canteen staff for communicable disease, obtained from the Competent Authority, shall be displayed in a prominent place inside the canteen
39. Two Nos. The garbage bin has to be kept by the contractor, one inside the canteen and one outside the canteen and to be cleaned twice a day and disposed off in the nearby garbage disposal bin of local Municipal Council and never to be dumped into the sea
40. Subletting of the canteen is not permitted
41. The canteen staff must behave well with the users and neatly dressed
42. Contractor must display approved rates in prominent place
43. The contractor may employ adequate number of employees at his expense for smooth and efficient running of the canteen. He is responsible for proper and polite behavior of his employees in the canteen towards staff and canteen committee members /representatives/students/guests etc.
44. The contractor will ensure that performance of the canteen is upto the satisfaction of the customers and the service of the canteen staff is prompt and there is no undue delay
45. The contract shall be cancelled at any time within the contract period for non-satisfactory performance or any reasons deemed fit by the College Authorities
46. A certificate from medical authority regarding condition of the canteen may also be open by the successful bidder when is require under rule
47. Outsiders are not permitted in the College Canteen and it is the responsibility of the contractor to look into it.
48. Any damages sustained to the Property shall be recovered from the contractor at the actual rate of replacement
49. **Arbitration:** In case of any dispute between the parties arising out of these contract that shall be settled amicably by the parties. In case of failure, the same shall be referred for arbitration to sole arbitrator appointed by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The decision of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding. The arbitrator appointed under this clause shall pass award within a period of 06 (Six months) reference made to him. Subject to aforesaid, the provisions of arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to arbitration proceeding under these clause. The arbitration proceeding under this clause will be held at Sri VijayaPuram.
50. If any contractor submits more than one bid by him or by his/her close relatives (Business or family relatives) to secure the contract in his favour all such bids will be disqualified and the firm will be blacklisted for a period as decided Principal, ANCOL.
51. Any unresolved issues shall be subject to jurisdiction of the Competent Court at Sri Vijaya Puram.
52. The Principal, ANCOL will reserve the right to accept or reject the tender without assigning any reason thereof.

## अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
