its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

**Special terms and conditions-Version:1 effective from 12-06-2025 for category Digital VHF Base / Mobile Transceiver Set as per MHA QR**

1. NOTE TO BUYER AND SELLER

1.) Any wireless equipment using Radio frequency needs a license for operation or possession under the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 and Indian Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1933 respectively. The operation, sale, or even possession of wireless apparatus without a valid License issued from WPC wing, Department of Telecommunications, Sanchar Bhawan, New Delhi is a punishable offense under the provision of the above-mentioned Acts. The law also prohibits the sale, hire, or transfer of wireless apparatus in any manner to any person, who is not in possession of a valid license issued in his name. Any attempt to enter the frequency used by the licensed band is also an offence under the above said Acts. All buyers and sellers are required to mandatorily comply with provisions.

2.) Required licenses are mandatorily required to comply with the Government of India guidelines. Moreover, Seller may need to submit valid and active license details, if required by the relevant buyer during procurement process.

3.) Sellers/ buyers shall adhere / comply to any other Security Guidelines / provisions of the Government of India as applicable to subject category.

4.) As per clause-3 of S.O. 982(E) published by Ministry of Communications, seller should have valid and active certificate in accordance with the standards and conformity assessment measures applicable to specified Telecommunication Equipments. During the procurement, buyer to verify the relevant certificate. 1. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. **Scope of Supply**

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing Commissioning of Goods and Training of operators and providing Statutory Clearances required (if any)

3. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

#### 4. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. Participating bidders must clarify in their offers whether they have submitted their offers as a trader/dealer/distributor or manufacturer.
2. Bidders participating as manufacturers must submit appropriate documents as proof of manufacturing. Bidders participating as traders must submit document for proof of manufacturing of their principal/OEM firm.
3. Participating bidders must refer the bid ATC carefully before submitting their bids.
4. Participating bidders must clarify the make/model of the offered item
5. The scope of supply (as given in bid terms and conditions) for the tendered item needs to be completed within the Delivery schedule.
6. If the supplied goods are found to be physically damaged, upon arrival at the consignee location, then it will be the responsibility of the supplier to replace those within one month free of cost. After one month period the consignee/buyer will not be responsible for that item (to be replaced) in any way.
7. It is to be noted that if the consignment (or any part of it) gets rejected due to non-compliance of bid terms and conditions (after inspection), then it will be the sole responsibility of the supplier to be replaced the rejected lot/ITEM within one month at their own risk and cost. After one month, the consignee and buyer will not be responsible for the rejected item in any way.
8. Apart from the total landed cost as mentioned in the GEM contract, no other charges/taxes/duties will be borne by the buyer organization in any way.
9. If the supplied items are in knocked down or semi assembled state or if there is a requirement of assembling those supplied items, it will be the sole responsibility of the supplier/seller to arrange for assembly and demonstration of the supplied items at their own cost and risk. This is mandatory for release of payment.
10. It will be the sole responsibility of the seller/supplier to arrange for manual labour/workmen/manpower for unloading of the supplied goods at the consignee site (at their own cost and risk). Seller organization should not be held responsible for this in any way.

11. All Central/State Government Organization/PSUs shall be exempted from submission of ePBG@5% (Security deposit).

12. **Warranty** : 3 Years Warranty on Radio and 1 Year on Accessories.

1. OEM Authorization Certificate (Tender specific) shall be submitted.

2. It is required for the bidder to submit the copy of the Valid Dealer Possession License (DPL) along with the bid.

3. It is required for the bidder to submit technical leaflet/datasheet having detailed technical specification of the offered product along with the bid.

4. Bidder shall provide & install programming software and provide programming Kit of Wireless Device.

5. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Supply, installation and commissioning.

6. Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period: The supplier shall be responsible for any defect that may, under the condition provided for by the contract and under proper use, arise due to faulty materials, design or workmanship and shall remedy such defect at his own cost.
