C. It shall be ensured by the bidder that he continues to be eligible for all the eligibility criteria mentioned above, throughout the tender period. If at any stage during the tender process or during the contract period, if any eligibility criterion is contravened, the bidder shall be declared ineligible and his bid rejected/contract terminated.

D. It shall be ensured by the bidder that he continues to be eligible for all the eligibility criteria mentioned above, throughout the tender period. E. BIDDING PROCEDURE AND SUBMISSION OF BIDS

The bidder must submit his e-bid in two parts on the GeM portal as mentioned below :-

Part 1 :- Called "Technical Bid" containing :-

(1) Documents establishing Bidder's eligibility (Technical Bid) : All documents as mentioned in the table given under the heading : "CRITERIA ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY OF BIDDERS AND DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED IN PROOF THEREOF" shall be scanned and uploaded as clear legible pdf documents. It is mandatory to upload all the documents - only bids complete in all respects will be considered.

(2) INSPECTION OF BIDDERS PREMISES If the Technical Bid on the basis of the documents mentioned in this section to be in fulfillment of eligibility, the premises of bidders will be inspected by a team of officers led by an officer not below the rank of (NFSG) for :-

- (a) Physical verification of location of the shop within the limits of _____.
- (b) Verification of original documents of those uploaded earlier during the bid.
- (c) Availability of proper cold-chain maintenance facilities, and power backup systems. d) Presence of retail outlet.
- (d) Assess availability of adequate stock of medicines and financial viability etc before opening the Commercial Bid.
- (e) Availability of computer and peripherals with internet connectivity to access indent on-line.
- (f) Confirm the availability of Bar Code Scanning and labeling facility including Bar Code Reader and Label marker and Software vendors' premises.

In case the team is not satisfied with the veracity of the claims of the bidder, he will be declared ineligible for participation in the further processes.

A single technical evaluation report shall be uploaded on the GeM portal, combining the report of technical evaluation of bid documents followed by inspection of bidder premises. Commercial Bid of only those bidders will be opened, only after technical evaluation of documents as well as inspection of chemist shop.

(3) Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide its Office Memorandum no, F.12/17/2019-PPD dated 06/02/2020 on subject "Predatory Pricing/ Abnormally Low Bids Reg" has defined "Abnormally low bid" as one in which the bid price, in combination with other elements of the bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. (In such a case, the discount % "predatory pricing" amounts to quoting exceptionally high discount). On opening of financial bids, if it is found that a bidder has bid for a number of ECHS Polyclinic, has quoted abnormally high discount making him the H1 and does not appear to have the financial capability to fully execute the contract (turnover of bidder abnormally low as compared to average annual expenditure of the ECHS Polyclinic(s) where he is the H1), then as per provisions under the OM mentioned above, the Station Commander shall seek through online portal (under "seek clarification"):

- (i) 20% of the total PBG value from the bidder, to be submitted as Demand Draft to the concerned Stn Cdr, within 48 hours, to prove financial capability. A scanned copy of DD shall also be uploaded on the online portal (GeM).
- (ii) Detailed price analysis with respect to the annual turnover, the number of ECHS Polyclinic bid for and the discount quoted.
- (iii) Allocation of risks and responsibilities.

In case the bidder is unable to fulfill either one or all or in any combination (i), (ii) and (iii) above, he shall be rejected online as H1 and no bid shall be made to him. In such a case, the rejected bidder shall cease to be H1 and the next highest discount offering bidder becomes H1. (i), (ii) and (iii) above shall be sought in turn from all H1 bidders suspected by deptt to have resorted to "predatory pricing" as explained above.

Part 2:- Called "Commercial Bid" or "Price Bid":-
