However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

Techno- commercial Terms & Conditions: -

1) Price Basis: - Rate shall remain FIRM throughout the contract period.

2) TAXES & DUTIES: As applicable at per actual.

3)Payment Terms: -

100% payment will be made after submission of bill subject to receipt & verification of instrument and calibration certificate by authorized person of DVC at DVC site.

Payment will be made in Non-GeM Mode i.e. offline mode.

Payment will be made on RA bill certified by DGM/Sr. Manager, O&E Cell, KTPS, DVC subject to satisfactory completion of the work.

The contractor shall raise the bill on completion of every month, which should be duly certified by the officer In-charge and the payment shall be done as per above payment term.

4) Scope of work and BOQ :

As per attachment.

5)PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BID :

(i) Bids shall remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the closing date prescribed by the Employer for the receipt of bids. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Employer as being nonresponsive.

(ii) In exceptional circumstances, the Employer may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the bid validity period. The request and responses thereto shall all be made by e-mail. If a Bidder accepts to extend the period of bid validity, the validity of bid security shall also be suitably extended. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A Bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its bid.

6) CONTRACT PERIOD:

The contract period shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the issuance of the work order.

7) IMPORTANT TERMS & CONDITIONS:

(a) Invoice to be raised separately with different rates of GST.

(b) Please submit Tax Invoice on supply of material/ service with prerequisites & statutory information within stipulated time as mentioned in the relevant provisions of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act 2017 and allied acts and rules made thereunder. In case the invoice is issued beyond the stipulated time as per GST act, then DVC will not be liable to reimburse any such taxes & duties paid under the GST Act. Further, the supplier of Goods/ Services indemnifies DVC from and against any loss / extra cost incurred by the company on account of default by the supplier or any of its third party in any statutory compliance of the GST Act.

8) AGREEMENT:

An agreement in DVC's prescribed format (Enclosed with the BID) shall be executed by the contractor on a non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100.00 (Rupees One Hundred) only.

Contract agreement shall be executed after receipt and verification of the requisite performance security (wherever applicable). The said agreement will be duly signed by the authorized representative of DVC and authorized signatory of Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant.

The Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant should acknowledge and unconditionally accept, sign, date and return the agreement within 14 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of OTE. Such acknowledgements may not be required in low value contract, below Rupees Two and a Half Lakh or when the bidders offer has been accepted in entirety, without any modifications. If both parties simultaneously sign the contract across the table, further acknowledgement from the supplier is not required.

Non- execution of Contract Agreement by the Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider within 30 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of OTE and 45 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of GTE, due to the fault of the Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider, will constitute sufficient ground for forfeiture of its EMD (wherever applicable) and shall short close the Contract and retender and in this retender such defaulting Bidder will not be allowed to participate.

9) LD CLAUSE & Risk purchase clause:

- I. DVC reserves the right to recover a sum equivalent to 0.5% of the value of the total contract value of the order for each week of delay and part thereof subject to maximum of 5% of the total value of the order as Liquidated Damage (LD) due to delay in completion of work attributable to the contractor.
- II. Alternatively, the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase the service from elsewhere at the sole risk and cost of the Vendor and recover all such extra cost incurred by the Purchaser in procuring the service by the above procedure.
- III. Alternatively, the Purchaser may cancel the Order completely or partly without prejudice to his right under the alternatives mentioned above.
- IV. In the event of recourse to alternative (ii) and (iii) above, the Purchaser will have the right to repurchase the service, to meet urgency in requirement caused by Vendors failure to comply with the schedule of delivery irrespective of the fact whether the materials are similar or not.

10) LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:

Except in cases of Criminal Negligence or wilful misconduct,

(i) The Contractor and The Employer shall not be liable to the Other Party for any indirect or consequential loss or damage, loss of use, loss of production, or loss of profits or Interest costs, provided that this exclusion shall not apply to any obligation of the Contractor to pay liquidated damages to the Employer

AND

(ii) The aggregate liability of the Contractor to the Employer, whether under the Contract, in tort or otherwise, shall not exceed the total Contract Price, provided that this limitation shall not apply to the cost of repairing or replacing defective equipment, or to any obligation of the Contractor to indemnify the Employer with respect to patent infringement, copy right, workman compensation.

11) SECURITY DEPOSIT -CUM -PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

3% of the contract value shall be retained as a security deposit and will be released after expiry of defect liability period. The performance security will be forfeited and credited to DVC's account in the event of a breach of contract by the contractor / Supplier / Service provider.

12) CANCELLATION/SHORT CLOSURE -

The Owner may terminate/short close the contract, by not less than 30 days written

written notice to you, to be given after occurrence of any of the events specified in the Sl. No. (a) to (e) of this clause and 60 days in the case of the event referred to Sl. No. (f), (g) & (h) below: a) The Vendor fails to comply with any of the terms of the Order or the bidder do not remedy a failure in the performance of their obligations under the Contract, within thirty (30) days after being notified or within any further period as the Owner may have subsequently approved in writing. b) The Vendor becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation. c) If as a result of Force Majeure, the Bidder is unable to supply materials for a period of not less than 60 days. d) If the Bidder, in the judgment of the Owner has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing or in executing the Contract. For the purpose of this clause. e) Corrupt Practice means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the selection process or in contract execution. f) Fraudulent Practice means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a selection process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Owner. g) The vendor is otherwise precluded from complying with any of the terms of the order on account of any directives of any lawful authority. h) If the Owner, at its sole discretion, decides to terminate this Contract. 14)VENDOR BILL TRACKING SYSTEM:

The Vendors on award of contract need to register themselves & submit their contract related bills online. After submission of the bill, a cover letter containing unique bill ID shall be generated which must be submitted to DVC along with other payment related documents in hardcopy.

15)SUB-LETTING:

Sub-letting is not allowed in this contract.

16)GOVERNING LAW(CLAUSE NO.30 OF GCC DVC): The Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with laws in force in India. The Courts of Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the Contract.

17)FORCE MAJEURE: As Per Clause 16 of the DVC's GCC.

18) WORK RELATED TERMS & CONDITIONS: -

- I. The firm will perform the subject work in accordance with the guidelines contained in the work order and the instructions of the 'Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative.
- II. Any deviation from the scope of work without the consent of the Engineer-in-Charge will not be allowed. Only the Engineer-in-Charge will be empowered to change

ange or modify the guidelines or instructions given or laid down earlier.

- III. In case of any doubt or contradiction, the decision of Engineer-in-Charge will be final.
- IV. Work Accident: The firm will be totally responsible for the safety of the workers employed by them. In the event of any work accident, major or minor, the firm's representative must take care of the injured person immediately and provide him the required treatment suggested by the doctor. The injured can be admitted to DVC hospital KTPS also for treatment by paying the charges as required.
- V. As the area of work is highly sensitive with respect to safety hazards, the responsible supervisors/ engineers of the firm must take proper work permit, shutdown clearance and other instructions from the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative daily before start of the work.
- VI. The Firm shall fully co-operate with DVC's other Contractors for associated plant and subsidiary as well as other similar activities.
- VII. Insurance: The Insurance of personnel employed in the job shall be done by the contractor. No compensation of any major/minor/disabilities/damage would be given by DVC, KTPS.
- VIII. Permit to Work: For any job 'Permit to Work' is to be obtained from the Engineer-in-charge of DVC or his authorized representative.
- IX. Precautionary measures to avoid damage of other equipment: The contractor should take care for safety of equipment and property of DVC, KTPS. Any loss to this effect will be contractor's responsibility entirely and they shall have to make good for the losses and extra expenditure incurred by DVC, KTPS thereof. Responsibility of the spares & materials issued to the Contractor rests with the contractor himself. Contractors have to replenish the same at his own cost & risk in case of loss/damage of the spare/material under his custody.
- X. Discipline: The contractor's employees should maintain proper discipline and behaviour and do not cause any hindrance to smooth running of the Power Plant or in execution of duties by DVC, KTPS Employees. Controlling Officer is fully empowered to ask the contractor to withdraw any worker/workers on charges of misconduct, incompetence/ negligence in discharge of duties and such worker/workers may not be deployed without his permission.

- XI. The contractor shall be fully responsible for his workers with regard to terms of employment. DVC is not responsible in any manner, whatsoever in respect of workers engaged by the contractor for carrying out the work at KTPS, DVC. During execution of the Contract as well as on expiry of the same, the contractor shall ensure that none of their employees/workers claims employment in DVC.

19) Other Terms and Conditions:

- I. **Travelling expenses:** Travelling expenses of the service engineer will be in the scope of bidder.
- II. **Fooding and Lodging:** During the visit of vendor personnel at KTPS site, Fooding and lodging to be arranged by their own (in the bidder's scope). However, Lodging may be provided on chargeable basis based on availability of room in Guest house.
- III. **Safety:** The party should strictly follow the prevailing safety norms of DVC regarding Projects and Works during execution of works. DVC will not be liable for any accidents or incidents resulting from any kind of unsafe acts.
- IV. These instruments are used for critical measurements related to turbine performance, flue gas composition, NDCT performance, energy audit data, and environmental compliance. Accuracy of measurements directly affects heat-rate calculations, unit performance assessment, and safety monitoring. OEM M/s Testo India Pvt. Ltd. is the competent and authorized agency for calibration, with traceability to PTB Germany / National standards.
- V. Replacement of the O₂ Sensor and CO-H₂ Compensated Sensor of Testo 350 is essential and it is part of calibration to restore the analyser normal functionality and ensure accurate flue gas measurements.
- VI. **Indemnity Bond Clause:**

The bidder/vendor shall execute a Composite Indemnity Bond for an amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only) on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/-, against the instrument taken from the site. The indemnity bond shall be valid for the entire duration of the contract, including any extensions thereof.
- VII. Pick up and drop of all instruments from KTPS ,DVC in the scope of vendor by its own arrangement.
- VIII. After receiving the calibrated instruments and its certificate, payment to be made as per DVC rules.

20)CONTROLLING OFFICER: The Sr. Manager (O&E),or their authorized representative.

21)SAFETY CLAUSE:

22) SPECIAL INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS:

(23) COMPLIANCE OF REGULATIONS (CLAUSE NO.22 OF GCC DVC):

The Vendor shall warrant that all Goods and/or services covered by this Purchase Order/ contract shall have been produced, sold, dispatched, delivered, tested and commissioned in strict compliance with all applicable laws, regulations including industries (Development & Regulations) Act, 1951 & Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 and any amendments there under, labour agreements, Safety rules and PF compliance, working conditions and technical codes and requirement as applicable from time to time. All laws, rules and regulations required to be followed in execution of the order / contract, must be complied with.

The Vendor should execute and deliver such documents as may be needed by the Purchaser/ owner in evidence of compliance. Any liability arising out of contravention of any of the laws on executing this order shall be the sole responsibility of the Vendor and the Owner shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever.

(24). TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -

The contractor would be bound by the terms and conditions as detailed in the GeM Bid/ GeM contract and DVC General Conditions of Contract (GCC) & General terms & conditions of GeM. (26) SECURITY GATE PASS:

The contractor must arrange Photo gate pass at his own cost for his workmen from the security department and the rules and regulations related to this subject shall be binding on the contractor. As KTPS, DVC is a protected area, necessary Photo Identity Pass of the persons engaged shall be arranged by the contractor or from the In Charge KTPS, the expenditure of photograph etc. shall be borne by the contractor.

(27) SCANNED COPIES OF ALL THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

Scanned Copies of all the required documents for meeting the qualifying criteria of the tender along with the bid documents shall have to be uploaded in GeM Portal during submission of bid on line for techno commercial evaluation and compliance thereof. Tenders will be processed on the basis of scanned copy of the documents submitted by the bidders.

(28) UNAUTHORIZED OCCUPATION/POSSESSION:

Unauthorized occupation/possession of Quarters/Shop/Plot of land of DVC will be treated as a disqualification and tender submitted/Contract awarded is liable to be rejected/cancelled, as the case may be, at any stage if the vendor or his authorized representative is found to be having such unauthorized occupation/possession.
