1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier

as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. 3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PROCUREMENT OF TRANSFER LADLE REFRAC TORY SETS

The intending vendor must satisfy conditions as stipulated below to qualify for consideration in techno-commercial evaluation. The intending vendor must submit documentary evidence in support of their eligibility failing which the offer is liable to be rejected.

TECHNICAL CRITERIA:

1. The bidder shall be an Indian manufacturer of Refractories (Class-I or Class-II local supplier as per Order No. P-45021/2/2017 PP (BEII) of DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce, GOI and subsequent amendments). The tenderer shall submit:
 - a. Self-attested copies of suitable documents like GST Registration / Business Licence / ISO certificate or any other Govt. certified document for evidence of bidder's status as manufacturer of the refractory material.
 - b. Certificate of value addition in India from competent authority and in specific format as stipulated in the tender.

1. **Past Experience Criteria:** The bidder should have successfully executed Purchase Orders (POs) during last five (5) years (end date is the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited), for supply of 70 % Alumina Bricks or higher quality bricks for Steel Ladles / Torpedo Ladles / Transfer Ladles / Charging Ladles / Hot Metal Ladles to any steel plant in India. The bidder is required to submit self-attested Purchase Orders and corresponding supply invoices/E-Way Bill/completion certificate/performance certificate for documentary evidence of execution of supplies. The purchase order should be from Govt. Organizations / PSUs / Public Limited Companies in India.

2. **Past Performance Criteria:** Vendors who qualify in (2) above must submit Performance Certificate(s) for the corresponding PO(s) as submitted for (2) above, for a minimum of 7 sets, wherein they must have achieved an average life of 90% of the Guaranteed life with reference to the submitted PO(s), for those number of (7) sets under consideration as above and within the time frame as given in Clause#2 above.
 3. In case, bidder, who conforms to Clause No. 1 of Eligibility Criteria or is a subsidiary or a sales unit of a parent company (manufacturer), then credentials / performance of either bidder or parent company will be considered (subject to parent company having majority ownership of the bidder) as per S. No. 2. In such cases documentary evidence for bidder being subsidiary of parent company and parent company having majority ownership of the bidder needs to be submitted. Both subsidiaries, sales unit, parent company participating in tender must comply with order no F.No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated: 23/07/2020 (& subsequent amendments) of Ministry of Finance regarding any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India.

FINANCIAL CRITERIA:

4. The financial turnover of the Bidder in any one of the last 3 financial years should be minimum Rs. 44.04 Lacs. It is to be supported by copies of audited P&L account / Balance sheet and shall contain the Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN).

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Other Criteria

5. Vendors included in SAIL's CVL (Common Vendor List) for Hot Metal Transfer Ladle (route-Mixer to Converter) shall automatically get qualified against the tender irrespective of fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
6. Offers of bidders on whom Purchase Orders were placed by BSP during the last 5 years (end date is the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited), for supply & application of items such as Converter Refractory Sets, Steel Ladle Refractory Sets, Torpedo Ladle Refractory Sets OR RH Degasser Refractory Sets, and whose Performance/Delivery/Application etc. had not been satisfactory, shall not be considered for this Tender, irrespective of their offer qualifying the above Clauses#2, 3, 5 & 6.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
