1. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE 25% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider

2. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

3. **Generic**

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

4. **Payment**

PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES: Service Provider is required to pay Salaries / wages of contracted staff deployed at buyer location first i.e. on their own and then claim payment from Buyer alongwith all statutory documents like, PF, ESIC etc. as well as the bank statement of payment done to staff.

5. **Certificates**

20. **Working Time:**
- 20.1 Normal Working time shall be of 12 Hours within a day (24 Hrs.) as per requirement of General duty/shift duty. Hence vehicle can be used round the Clock as per the requirement of the project job. However, the duty can be extended beyond 12 Hrs. under any exigency with applicable overtime.
- 20.2 Daily reporting timings, reporting and closing points shall be fixed by BHEL's Vehicle In-charge. Beyond normal working hours, if the vehicle is required by BHEL, the same should not be refused as above.
- 20.3 As per requirement, BHEL reserves the right to use the vehicle for local trips and also outside trips (within the State) without any extra cost implication to BHEL.
- 20.4 One day in a month shall be given as Rest day for the vehicle for maintenance, at the discretion of BHEL's Vehicle In-charge based on convenience.
- 20.5 In case of non-availability of vehicle due to breakdown or other reasons, owner has to arrange for providing a suitable alternate and acceptable vehicle. If the owner fails to arrange alternate vehicle as above, BHEL may arrange the vehicle at owner's cost with additional penalty of Rs.500/Taxi/per day for such occasions.
- 20.6 Vehicle would eligible/allowed for on up & down garage distance (Km) of 4 Km from the first pick up point to last drop point.

21. **Consumption Charges:**

- 21.1 Fuel Consumption Charges will be paid as 1 Litre fuel Cost @ 10 Km for vehicle running. Fuel Bill shall be submitted for each such occasions of refueling the vehicle along with the monthly bill to arrive at the fuel rate. In case of any ambiguity Average rate of fuel for the billing month would be taken and the document for the same is to be provided by the vendor from any filling station within Korba District with Seal and Signature of the Manager /Authority of Filling Station.
- 21.2 Engine oil charges shall be paid extra @Rs. 700/- for every 500 KM running of vehicle or part thereof on submission of bill.
- 21.3 Over time Charges, if any, will be paid @Rs. 60 per hour (after 12 hours of working time), which is to be shared with the driver.

22. **Other Terms & Conditions for Vehicle & Driver:**

- The vehicle must have a valid Taxi Permit, R.C. Book, Comprehensive Insurance, Fitness Certificate, Pollution Under Control (PUC) Certificate, Driving License, and other required documents by RTO, which must always be available in the vehicle for inspection
- The vehicle owner must possess all documents under the Motor Vehicle Act, including commercial registration with a permit (at least state permit), and is solely responsible for legal compliance.
- Vehicle to be deployed need to run on Diesel.
- The vehicle should be maintained in good, neat & clean condition throughout the service period as regards to mechanical condition, vehicle internals, cleaning, etc.
- Toll tax, Parking Fees, if any, shall be paid by owner and will be reimbursed at actual/ as certified by BHEL's Vehicle In-charge along with monthly bill on submission of receipts.
- The driver must hold a valid professional commercial driving license.
- The owner will provide trained and experienced driver having valid driving license and insurance coverage at owner's cost, copy of which is to be submitted to BHEL.
- The driver deployed should have decent behavior and good moral character and should not be a minor and have clean antecedents.
- The driver should follow and obey all traffic rules. Any penalties imposed by traffic authorities for violations shall be borne by the owner.
- One mobile phone shall be provided to the driver and should be maintained in working condition at all times (round the clock).
- Driver/Owner must maintain a daily journey logbook. Which must be filled daily/trip-wise and signed & certified by the user. Billing will be based on daily trip/run details from this logbook.
- Demurrage to any public property/life caused by the vehicle during duty hours or otherwise would be at the sole responsibility of the owner and to be borne by the owner.

- Vehicle provider should do all the formalities for Gate pass of Vehicle and Driver. Cost incurred for the same has to be borne by the vehicle owner.
- The tentative running of the vehicle will be approximately 2500 km per month. However, the vehicle may be required to run up to 3500 km per month under the same terms and conditions, without any reservations, as per site requirements.
- The mileage meter must be in working condition and covered; if tampered with, BHEL reserves the right to reject the vehicle without notice
- The vehicle must be equipped with the following safety devices/accessories:
 1. Seat belts
 2. First Aid Box (Band-Aid, Pain Killer Tablets, Bandage, Mercuric Chrome, Dettol, Cotton, Neosporin Ointment, etc.)
 3. Small working Fire Extinguisher
 4. Stepney (spare wheel)
 5. Torch with three cells
- Agency should have PF & ESIC registration and Driver being deputed should have PF & ESIC no.
- Any compensation payable to a driver or third party under statutory rules shall be the sole responsibility of the owner, and BHEL shall not be responsible.
- The owner must provide regular driver (without frequent Change) and pay minimum wages or more as per Government norms, including allowances and statutory provisions.
- Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque or Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

Note: (i) BHEL reserves the right to cancel the tender in full or in part without assigning any reason, whatsoever.

(ii) The contract may be terminated by either party by giving one month's prior notice under normal circumstances. However, in cases of poor service, or any disciplinary issues, the contract may be terminated by giving 15 days' notice.

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its

outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.

12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
