1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. The above items are required strictly as per specifications.
2. If the authorized channel partners of OEMs are participating in the bid then they have to submit the bid specific OEM authorization certificate, failing which offer will be summarily rejected.
3. The bidders are required to submit the declaration regarding percentage of local content of the offered product(s) from the OEM and component wise details of local content with location of value addition failing which their offer shall be liable to be rejected.
4. . In case of offers from Micro and Small enterprises (Manufacturer of the product quoted), the value/financial limits applicable for Eligibility criteria for work experience and Eligibility criteria for Average Annual Turnover of OEM/Bidder shall be 75% of the corresponding values for these criteria.
5. Make and Model offered through GeM Catalogue and through documents submitted alongwith with bids shall be same, failing which offer is liable to be rejected.
6. In case of offers from Micro and Small Enterprises (Manufacturer of the offered products), the value/financial limits applicable for Eligibility criteria for work experience for bulk ordering and Eligibility criteria for Average Annual Turnover for bulk ordering shall be 75% of the corresponding values for these criteria (subject to their offer meeting of quality and technical specifications).
7. In case of offers from Micro and Small Enterprises (Manufacturer of the offered products) and Start-Up regi

stered with DPIIT as Start-Up, Such Micro and Small Enterprises and Start-ups shall be exempted from payment of Earnest Money.

8. EMD shall be accepted only through online mode.
9. A bidder shall participate either as OEM or Authorised channel partner of the OEM and not both.
10. Tenderer not submitting the requisite information may note that his offer is liable to be ignored. In case the tenderers do not submit the requisite documents/evidence in regard to qualifying requirements as mentioned above along with their e-offer the tender will be decided on the basis of their past supply performance records/credentials as available with COS Office, DMRC. Shortfall information/ documents should be sought only in case of historical documents which pre-existed at the time of tender opening and which have not undergone change since then. So far as submission of documents is concerned with regard to eligibility/qualification criteria, after submission of tender, only related shortfall documents must be asked for and considered. For e.g. if the bidder has submitted a PO without its completion/ performance certificate, such certificate can be asked for and considered. However, no new supply order should be asked for so as to qualify the bidder”.
11. In case the tenderer participates as an authorised channel partner of OEM then the performance as required above shall be that of the OEM/principal (i.e. of offered Make) which has authorised the channel partner. It may so happen that the agent has credentials of past supply for a different principal but this will not be considered as performance for placing bulk order in case of change of OEM/principal. Further, in such cases the purchaser also reserves the right to examine the credentials of the authorised channel partner also.
12. i) The Bidder / OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)}, should have executed project for supply and installation / commissioning of same or similar Category Products of Offered Make during preceding 3 financial years (i.e. current year and three previous financial years) as on opening of bid, as per following criteria:-
 - a) Single order of at least Rs. 8,81,370.00 or;
 - b) Two orders of at least Rs. 5,03,640.00; or
 - c) Three orders of at least Rs. 3,77,730.00ii) The similar categories will be Printer/QR Printer/Receipt printer etc.
iii) In case item is not sold separately and it was part of a complete product then it is required to submit the details (cost etc.) separately for the required item.
13. “For fulfilling the experience criteria the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:-
 - a) “Contract/Purchase Order/LOA, copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed. In addition bidders shall be required to submit any of the following documents, Execution Certificate/Supply acceptance Certificate/ Completion Certificate/performance certificate/Self-Certified CRAC (Consignee Receipt and Acceptance Certificate) to verify the supply credentials. Documents shall be properly signed and stamped/Digitally signed by the respective organisation”.
 - b) In case the supply is executed for Private Client, In addition to above documents required against past experience bill of quantities, bill wise details of payment received certified by C.A. containing the details of TDS (Tax deducted at source) referring the relevant entry/ies in the T.D.S certificates (26AS), T. D.S certificates for all payments received and copy of final/last bill paid by client shall also be submitted. All the documents or certifications, which are provided by CA after 1st July, 2019, must contain UDIN thereon and the particulars of certifications must be same as mentioned on document/certification and submitted to ICAI on its website which can be verified online on <https://udin.icai.org/search-udin>.
 - c) The Value of work shall be updated to tender submission date assuming 5% inflation for Indian Rupees every year and 2 % for foreign currency portions per year. For the purpose of evaluation of work experience, all prices will be converted to India Rupees using the Exchange (selling) rates for those currencies at the close of business of the State Bank Of India at 31st December of each year for the works completed in respective year. For the works completed in the latest year before 31st of December of current year, the exchange rates of foreign currency shall be applicable as on the date of bid opening (price bid in case of single bid/packet tenders and technical bid in case of two bid/packet tenders).
 - d) The tenderer shall submit details of supplies executed by them in the below format of for the SUPPLY to be considered for qualification of past experience criteria.

14. In case of any composite supply (supply involving other than same/similar items also or same/similar item being a part of the whole item), in such case the value of same/similar item shall be submitted that can be considered for qualification of past performance/experience.

15. a) "The details of deviations, if any, should be clearly submitted as per the format given in Annexure 'A' in Buyer uploaded Bid ATC".

b) All implicit and explicit deviations, remarks and comments mentioned elsewhere in the tenderer's proposal shall be treated as NULL and VOID and considered withdrawn unconditionally. Tenderers may note that conditions deviating from the tender conditions/ description/specifications may render the offer liable to be ignored.

16. Warranty terms :- **18 Months From the supply or 12 month from the date of installation whichever is earlier.**

17. LOCAL CONTENT CRITERIA:-

i) The bidders are required to submit the percentage of local content as per Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 19th July, 2024 (as amended from time to time).

ii) Seller / Service Provider, in line with Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 19th July, 2024 (as amended from time to time), **shall provide self certification for local content in the quoted item (goods / services) at the time of bidding.** However, at the time of execution of the contract, for all contracts above ₹ 10 Crore, the seller / service provider shall be required to give local content certification duly certified by cost / chartered accountant in practice. For cases where it is not possible to provide certification by cost / chartered accountant at the time of execution of contract, the seller / service provider shall be permitted to provide the certificate for local content from cost / chartered accountant after completion of the contract, within time limit acceptable to the Buyer.

In case Seller / Service Provider does not meet the stipulated local content requirement and the category of the Seller/ Service Provider changes from Class-I to Class-II / Nonlocal supplier or from Class-II to Non-local supplier, a penalty upto 10% of the contract value may be imposed. However, contract once awarded shall not be terminated on this account.

iii) False declaration(s) regarding percentage of local content in line with Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 19th July, 2024 (as amended from time to time) by Sellers/ Service Providers will be treated as breach of the Code of Integrity under Rule 175(1)(i)(h) of General Financial Rules for which the Sellers /Service Providers or its successors can be debarred for up to two years as per Rule 151(ii) of General Financial Rules along with such actions as may be permissible under law.

iv) Decisions on complaints, including prescribed fees, relating to implementation of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 (as amended from time to time) will be taken by Competent Authority empowered to look into procurement related complaints relating to procuring entity.

18 EMD shall be accepted only through online mode failing which offer is liable to be rejected.

19 PBG shall be submitted in the prescribed attached format.

20 Bidders are required to submit proper data sheet of the offered product, merely copy paste of the required specification may not be considered a proper data sheet (may not be considered for evaluations) and failing which offer is liable to be rejected.

If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1

bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
