1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
6. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

7. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

10. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

* Any bidder, who proposes alterations to any of the conditions, specifications laid down in this document or inserts any new condition, will be rejected.

* Scope of Work :- The scope of the work/supplies of items covered in this supply is as per technical specification mentioned in bid documents/DCS.

* All bidder to upload following documents alongwith the bid :-

(a) In case the bidder is a reseller, he/she must upload bid specific reseller certificate provided by OEM for the bid duly mentioning bid number alongwith date.

(b) Turnover of OEM of last three FY must be provided by bidder.

(c) CA certificate mentioning turnover of reseller of last three FY must be provided by bidder.

(d) Prospective bidders are required to provide warranty certificate for every product as provided by OEM. warranty as per above clause is for replacement of defective item (S). Defective item / Product will be replaced/Delivered within 30 days from the date of intimation given by the department at consignee location or as directed by consignee. Suppliers shall bear all expenses for such transactions.

* Vendor other than OEM shall upload bid specific authorization of OEM for all branded items. Bidders are required to upload the MRP/Pricelist of product/ item alongwith Brand duly stamped and signed by Bidder.

* Bidder has to submit certificate regarding acceptance of all the terms and conditions and also bidder has to submit Experience, Past Performance, Bidder Turnover, OEM Turnover, OEM Authorisation, Warrant Certificate, MII as per specified format, MSE/MSME, EMD exemption as applicable, Firm documents such as Pan Card, NEFT Mandate duly verified by Bank, Firm GS TIN and Cancelled Cheque .

* The bidders cannot impose any of the conditions. Conditions of the ATC are binding. The decision of the Departmental Board of Officer for Technical Evaluation Committee will be final and binding.

* The documents can be verified by department from OEM by Mail/Speed Post, thus all details shall be provided by bidder/OEM. In case the documents are found to be fraud the bidder shall be rejected and matter will be reported to GeM.

* Bidder has to survey the site location as mentioned below and obtain the required documents/drawings from GE (NW) NOFRA before bidding and upload the same duly accepted at the time of Bid submission. No bidder will be accepted by the authority without survey of the location, the buyer has all rights to disqualify the bidder who participate in bid without surveying the site work location.

* The bidders must be fully acquaint themselves with payments procedures of the MES i.e. payment will be made post inspection of supplied items/services by BOO.

* Bidder financial standing : The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

* Bidder are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards.

* EMD amount to be given in Favour of CWE (NW) Mumbai.

* Warranty certificate is mandatory for all branded items.

* The OEM must give guarantee letter of behalf of reseller.

* Test certificate of items is must upload in bid.

* Required catalogue number, model number, MRP and technical specification with Bid number shall be mentioned of the offered product on letterhead of respective OEM for all branded products.

* Required NABL certificate, BIS License and Test Certificate of all branded products.

* In case the documents are found to be fraud the bidder shall be blacklisted permanently.

* The documents can be verified by department from respective OEM by mail/post, thus all details shall be provided by Bidder/OEM. In case documents are found to be fraud the bidder shall be rejected and matter will be reported to GeM authorities.

* Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificate/documents sought in the Bid document, the Bidder shall be Technically disqualified.

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (PQC) FOR SOLAR POWER PROJECT

1. Reference E-in-C's Branch letters No A/37696/OSDPUPol/E2W (PPC) dated 23 Feb 18 (Policy No 02/2018) and amendment dated 08 Jun 18 (Policy No 05/2018).

2. Based on inputs from environment and MNRE, PQC has been formulated for uniformity in criteria for selection of contractors for issue of tenders by CEs Zone.

3. PQC has been re-formulated considering the following aspects :-

(a) Technical Capability . Suggestions given by CEs Command that eligibility criteria should be based on capacity of plants installed, rather than the amount as given in chapter on e-tendering for building works costing more than 50 crore, is logical, since due to various incentives given by Government to promote renewable energy, per MW cost of this technology is coming down.

(b) Class/ Category of Enlisted Contractor . As there is no separate category of enlistment for Solar works as of now, enlisted contractors bidding directly (W/o MoU) also have to meet criteria given in the Appendix to qualify. However enlisted contractors are exempted from submission of documents except experience criteria for direct bidding.

(c) MoU with Eligible Solar Power Firms . The solar power firms are graded by the rating agency on a 5x3 matrix broadly based on their performance capability and financial strength. However, unlike class of contractor enlisted in MES, there is no clear cut demarcation regarding their upper financial limit or capability of installing solar plants. Hence, the firms having 'Highest/ High' performance rating (of 5x3 matrix) ie 1A, 1B, 1C, 2A, 2B and 2C, are only considered. The major role/ function of the MES enlisted as also the un-enlisted contractors envisaged in these projects is that of the capital investor. Thus in a MoU the performance capability of eligible solar power firms and financial capability of the contractor will result in an overall efficient pricing/ quoting of tenders.

(d) Engineering Establishment . Apart from the make and technology of solar power plants, location and direction of installation are important factors in determining its efficiency. As such, no sophisticated technology is involved in installing the panels and connecting them to grid. As eligible solar power firms with established credentials are associated with the work, separate engineering establishment is not being specified for eligibility criteria. The provisions related to supervisory staff given in Condition 25 of IAFW-2249 is considered sufficient to supervise the work.

4. The bidding by contractors/ firms will be governed by following :-

(a) In a tender, the eligible solar power firms can either bid as direct participant/ bidder or under MoU with MES enlisted/un-enlisted contractor, but cannot bid simultaneously for the same tender as direct participant/ bidder as also under MoU with MES enlisted/ un-enlisted contractor.

(b) MoU will be permitted between only one eligible solar power firm and one MES enlisted/ un-enlisted contractor, bidding for the same tender.

(c) In case any violation of condition at 4 (a) & (b) above is noticed, all such bids shall be treated as invalid.

5. PQC formulated keeping in view the above aspects to be included in NIT for Solar Power Plants is enclosed as Appendix. The same shall be followed for all Solar Power Projects irrespective of cost.

6. This letter may please be circulated to formations under your AOR for strict implementation forthwith.

7. This HQ letters referred at Para 1 above shall be treated as superseded.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR TENDER FOR SOLAR POWER PLANTS

(A) For MES Enlisted Contractors with MoU.

(i) Contractor of Class* (and below eligible class as per existing policy) shall be considered eligible.

(ii) Contractor should have MoU with solar power firms having criteria as given at (C) (i) & (ii) below.

(iii) They should not have any adverse remark in work load return of competent engineer authority.

(B) For un-enlisted Contractors with MoU.

(i) Contractors meeting the criteria of enlistment, annual turnover, financial criteria, solvency, working capital in MES.

(ii) Contractor should have MoU with solar power firms having criteria as given at (C) (i) & (ii) below.

(iii) No recovery outstanding in Government Department.

(iv) They should not have any adverse remark in work load return of competent engineer authority.

(C) For enlisted/ un-enlisted Contractor/ Solar Power Firm bidding directly.

In addition to eligibility criteria mentioned above for enlisted contractors at A (i) & (iii) and for un-enlisted contractors at B (i), (iii) & (iv), following criteria shall be fulfilled :-

(i) Experience of having successfully completed Solar Power Plants in MES/ any Central Government department/ State Government department / Central or State PSU during last seven years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be any of the following :-

(a) One work of capacity 80% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.

or

(b) Two works of capacity 50% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.

or

(c) Three works of capacity 40% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.

(ii) Solar power firms should have rating 1A/ 1B/ 1C/ 2N 2B/ 2C given by CRISIL/ CARE/ FITCH/ ICRA/ SMERA/ Brick Work Ratings India Pvt Ltd.

Appropriate class to be mentioned based on estimated cost of work.

Notes :-

(a) No contractor (enlisted or un-enlisted) will be allowed to execute the work by subletting or through power of attorney holder on his behalf to a third party/ another firm except sons/ daughters of proprietor/ partner/ Director, Project Manager as per contract conditions.

(b) For works exceeding 5 crore, the average annual turnover to be specified shall be as given in Para 3.5.3.1 of Manual on Contracts 2020.
