Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. Special terms and conditions-Version:2 effective from 29-01-2025 for category Customised Ambulance with Equipment

1. Special Terms and Conditions for Customized Ambulance with Equipment

This category is created to cater to the requirement of buyer where the buyer wants to procure Ambulance with medical devices and/or minor fabrications. This category is bid only category and Direct Purchase is not enabled.

1. The buyer shall define the equipment required in the Ambulance with complete technical specifications along with quantity. The buyer may refer AIS 125 (Part2) for list of equipment.
2. In case fabrication is required by the buyer inside the body of the Ambulance, details and drawings/pictures shall be provided by the buyer in the bid.
3. The buyer should check compliance of the vehicle to CMVR rules and compliance to AIS 125 (Part1) after fabrication and installation of medical devices.

Note for Sellers :

- For listing a catalog on GeM, the seller should specify the price for the vehicle. As the category is bid-only, the seller can submit their offer price while participating in the bid, based on the scope of work provided by the buyer.
- The seller should upload images that include the vehicle's front view, side view, and rear view with the door open.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. **Generic**

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. **Generic**

Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.

4. **Generic**

Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Configuration, Training (if any - which ever is applicable as per scope of supply) is to be carried out by OEM / OEM Certified resource or OEM authorised Reseller.

5. **Generic**

Manufacturer Authorization: Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

6. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

7. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

8. **Certificates**

The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.

Terms and conditions

Note: Bidder must also provide the compliance of terms and conditions mentioned below

1. Supply shall include Supply, Installation and Testing and commissioning. The vendor will have to arrange for all the testing equipment & tools required for installation, testing & maintenance etc.
2. Bidder must provide compliance of each point of Technical Specification (Accepted) along with documentary proof/literature(in one single file).
3. **Bidder must upload the compliance certificate of specifications of the item along with compliance of all the bid terms and conditions ,failing which bid shall be summarily rejected.**

4. Bidder must quote make/model of each instrument being offered by the bidder.
5. **If the seller fails to complete the delivery in due date, Director FRI shall have right to cancel the contract.**
6. **Defect free product**-The acceptance of the order shall automatically carry with it a warranty on suppliers part that every material supplied there under, shall be fresh and not time barred, shall be free from all defects and shall be constant with the established and generally accepted standards or the material of the type ordered for and in full conformity with the specifications. If it is found otherwise, when put into actual use, it shall be replaced by the suppliers at their cost even after the payment of their bills has been made.
7. **Warranty**-Warranty period of **03 years(for each item)** will start from the date of successful installation of the equipment. Warranty shall include free maintenance of the whole equipment (s) supplied including free replacement of parts. The defects, if any, shall be attended to on immediate basis but in no case any defect should prolong for more than 48 hours. The comprehensive warranty includes onsite warranty with parts. The defects, if any, during the warranty period are to be rectified free of charge by arranging free replacement wherever necessary. This includes cost, insurance, freight, custom duty, octroi, local taxes, if any, should be borne by the beneficiary or his agent. An undertaking to this effect should also be submitted along with the bid.
8. **Fall Clause**: The Bidder must provide undertaking that it has not supplied/is not supplying similar product/systems or subsystems OR providing similar services at a price/charge lower than that offered in the present bid in respect of any other ministry/department of the government of India or PSU and if it is found at any stage that similar product/systems or sub systems was supplied by the bidder to any of the ministry/department of the government of India or a PSU at a lower price, then the very price with due allowance for elapsed time will be applicable to the present case and the difference in the cost would be refunded by the bidder to FRI Dehradun , even if the contract has already been concluded.
9. Please note that the L1 Bidder may be asked to prove reasonability of rates quoted by the bidder.
10. **The seller must have an OEM authorization certificate.**
11. In the event the Goods delivered by the Seller do not conform with the Order whether by reason of not being of the quality or in the quantity or measurement stipulated or being unfit for the purpose they are required, the Buyer shall have the right to reject such goods
12. **PENALTY**

In case the Firm fails to commence/ execute the work as stipulated in the agreement or there is a breach of any terms and conditions of the tender and reserves the right to impose the penalty as detailed below

13. SECURITY

The seller has to submit a security (Performance Bank Guarantee) in the form of FDR (Fixed Deposit Receipt)in favour of DIRECTOR, FOREST RESEARCH INSTITUTE, DEHRADUN to Purchase Section, FRI which will be released after the successful completion of service/warranty.
14. All the pages of the bid being submitted online must be signed and stamped by the bidder irrespective of the nature of the content of the documents.
15. In case of any disputes on execution of the work during the period of contract, the decision of the Director, ICFRE-FRI Dehradun shall be binding

ng and final, agreeable in full by both the parties.

16. Supplier must supply the ambulance ready to use for hospital patient transport.

17. Bidder must agree to provide medical equipments as specified in the bid with applicable OEM warranty.

Note

In case of mismatch of the technical specification of buyer added ATC specification and General Category Specification of GeM, the Technical specification of buyer added ATC specification will only prevail.
