1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the

bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

6. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

8. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

9. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE 50% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 50 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 50 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 50 percent with the consent of the service provider

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- The bidder should have valid experience in providing mess canteen catering services in Government Institutions for a minimum period of 3 years.
- The bidder must submit copies of valid GST Registration, PAN Card, FSSAI License, and other statutory registrations.
- The bidder should have an operational office in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh. Submission of local registration / establishment registration vendor documents is necessary.
- The agency should maintain proper hygiene, cleanliness, and food quality standards in the mess premises.
- The contractor shall provide breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks as per the approved menu and schedule.
- The food materials used should be fresh, good quality, and within expiry date.
- RO water should be used for cooking purpose.
- Disposal of food waste is the responsibilities of the canteen contractor.
- Minimum 2 Nos. of fly catcher Machines to be provided/installed in the canteen.

10. The contractor shall issue ID card to its deployed employees.
11. The contractor shall deploy sufficient trained manpower for cooking, serving, and cleaning purposes.
12. The mess contractor shall ensure regular cleaning of kitchen equipment, utensils, dining hall, and surrounding area.
13. No subletting of the contract shall be allowed without prior approval of the department/institute.
14. The successful bidder shall deposit Security Deposit/Performance Security as per tender terms/GeM rules.
15. The contract may be terminated if the quality of food or services is found unsatisfactory.
16. Penalty may be imposed for poor quality food, unhygienic conditions, delay in service, or non-compliance of tender conditions.
17. The contractor shall arrange LPG cylinders, cooking utensils, kitchen tools, and other required materials at their own cost unless otherwise specified.
18. Payment shall be made on monthly basis after satisfactory completion of services and submission of bills.
19. The department/institute reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason.
20. The contractor shall follow all safety, health, and fire regulations during the contract period.
21. The rates quoted by the bidder shall remain fixed during the contract period and no escalation shall be allowed unless approved by the competent authority.
22. The agency must ensure uninterrupted mess services throughout the contract period.
23. All workers deployed shall be medically fit and properly uniformed.
24. Child labour shall not be employed under any circumstances.
25. Applicable deductions such as TDS & GST TDS shall be made as per Government rules.
26. No advance payment shall be made.
27. The selected service provider shall be required to pay a monthly License Fee of Rs. 1,500/- plus GST@18% towards the use of institutional premises for operating catering/canteen services. The license fee shall be payable monthly in advance and deposited with the Institute within the prescribed due date. The Institute reserves the right to revise and recover dues and take appropriate action in case of default in payment.
28. The number of Canteen staff shall be engaged on duty by Catering agency for work as per CIPET instruction. If the number is less due to illness, leave, transfer or any other reason whatsoever, the catering agency is bound to provide their replacement immediately to meet the required number of staff as per instruction.
29. CIPET: CSTS, Varanasi may request Catering agency to remove any particular person or persons of Catering agency, from the premises of CIPET: CSTS, Varanasi for administrative reasons and it shall be complied with forthwith.

30. Catering agency shall be responsible for the compliance of police verification of their staff; relevant document shall be submitted to CIPET. This shall be applicable to all the staff engaged by agency.

31. The contractor/Catering Agency shall be responsible for the compliance of all legal provisions connected with the employment of the Canteen staff posted at CIPET: CSTS, Varanasi premises and for due payments of any statutory dues payable if any e.g. on contribution under E.S.I. scheme, P.F, G.S.T., Minimum Wages Act, payment of Bonus Act, payment of wages act etc. all such liabilities if any, shall be discharged by Catering agency. If catering agency fails to pay such liability the payment will be adjusted from their security deposit or upcoming bills, etc.

32. In case of failure to comply with the above statutory Rules, Acts, the authorities shall have the right to impose penalty or cancel the contract and forfeit security deposits or EMD if any.

33. The rates quoted in the financial bid and agreed upon shall not be revised for any reason whatsoever and shall remain fixed throughout the duration of the agreement.

34. In case, any theft or pilferage is detected or any damages to any property and the same is due to negligence/ carelessness of Canteen personnel of Catering agency then the cost of loss or damage thereby will be fully recovered or replaced/ repaired with the same by Catering agency up to the satisfaction of CIPET: CSTS, Varanasi Authority.

35. The contract is for a period of 2 years. The contract will be initially for a period of one year which is extendable for another one more year based on the quality of service provided.

अस्वीकरण/**Disclaimer**

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.

11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्यवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms

of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
