#### **22. SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

(i) **SCHEDULE OF QUANTITIES**

You are requested to give offer for the repair of one number of stator which will also include

- a) Labour cost
- b) Material cost
- c) To and fro Transportation charges

(ii) **INSPECTION:** After completion of the rewinding job of the motor, testing of the same should be carried out in presence of our authorized engineer. For this prior intimation should be given to us after completion of the job.

(iii) **TEST CERTIFICATE:** You shall submit test certificate in triplicate after testing of the repaired stator.

(iv) **LOADING AND UNLOADING OF STATOR** Loading and unloading of the stator at our site will be done by us.

(v) **DELIVERY:** You shall deliver the Motor after completing all the works specified and duly tested within 120 days or earlier from the date of Collection of the motor from our works.

(vi) **QUANTITY:-** The quantity of the work mentioned above is 02 Numbers. However only 1 motor can also be sent . Motor would be sent as and when required one at a time .

(vii) **INDEMNITY BOND:** An Indemnity bond equivalent to the value of aforesaid motor for Rs.12,00,000(Rupees Twelve Lakhs only) drawn on a non judicial stamp paper of appropriate value in favour of M/s Hindustan Copper Limited, Malanjkhand Copper Project shall be submitted by you. This indemnity bond must be valid upto the period of contract or till such time the stator is repaired and delivered. In case of any damage/loss etc. you shall be responsible to make the loss good to HCL/MCP equivalent to the cost of the stator and in that event, you shall not be paid the rewinding charges.

(viii) **VALIDITY OF THE CONTRACT:** - The work order/contract shall be valid for two year from the date of issue of the work order or completion of the contracted value, whichever is later.

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(ix) **TRANSPORTATION:** To and Fro transportation of the motor shall be arranged by bidder. One motor at a time as per emergency would be provided.

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(x) **SCRAP:** Scrapcoils should be shown to the authorized engineer In charge of HCL and has to be retained by the bidder ( salvage).

(xi) **EXTRA WORK:** In case any extra work is to be carried out other than that mentioned schedule of quantities as per work order, the nature and quantity of work will be assessed in presence of our engineer. You shall submit a separate offer for the same.

(xii) **PRICE:** Price is to be quoted after deduction of salvaged material value.

**(xiii) WARRANTY:** The Rewinding Party hereby warrants that the motor rewinding and repair work carried out shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of supply/delivery of the repaired motor. In the event of any defect or failure arising during the warranty period due to faulty workmanship or materials used in the rewinding process, the Rewinding Party shall, at its own cost and expense, repair or rewind the motor free of charge, including labor and materials.

## **7. PERFORMANCE SECURITY (SECURITY DEPOSIT)**

7.1 The successful Tenderer shall deposit an amount equivalent **to 10% of the total Contract/ Work Order value including GST.**

7.2 Out of this, the initial Security Deposit will amount to 5% of the total Contract/ Work Order value including GST. The Initial Security Deposit is to be deposited by the successful Tenderer within 30 (Thirty) days from the date issue of Letter of Intent/Work Order, whichever is earlier, in the form of Insurance Security Bond/ /NEFT/RTGS/Fixed Deposit Receipt/Bank Guarantee (on HCL's format) from a Scheduled Commercial Bank except Co-operative and Gramin Bank for Goods/Services/Works/EPC Contracts. In case of Bank Guarantee, it has to be as per HCL's prescribed format.

7.3 The Security Deposit equivalent to the balance 5% of the total Contract/ Work Order value including GST will be recovered from the progressive bills of the contractor @10% from each RA Bill. However, after every six months, 50% of the accumulated retention money can be refunded to the contractor against submission of equivalent amount of Bank Guarantee (BG) from scheduled commercial bank.

7.4 HCL is at liberty, after having given fourteen (14) days written notice to the contractor, to realize and/or for unsatisfactory performance of the contract or any clauses thereof.

7.5 The above security amount shall remain fixed during the entire period of the contract irrespective of any decrease/increase in the value of contract due to any reason like increase/decrease in labour wages, price indices, change order, etc., during the execution of the contract.

7.6 In case the Security Deposit is furnished by way of Bank Guarantee, it must be initially valid for the entire contract period plus Defect Liability Period (DLP) plus 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the Contractor/contractor, including warranty obligations.

7.7 A penal interest @18% per annum shall be collected from the bidders on a pro-rata basis on account of any delay towards submission of SD/ Bank Guarantee amount after the assigned period of 30 days.

7.8 Only after submission of SD, the EMD of Successful Bidder will be refunded.

7.9 Payment of Contractor will be withheld until receipt of Performance Security/ Security Deposit.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

**All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.**

**For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.**

**The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:**

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

**All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.**

This Bid is governed by the [सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
