1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

2. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is

validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

### 1. **Generic**

**OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

### 2. **Inspection**

**Nominated Inspection Agency:** On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:  
Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC):

By BHEL/TPIA at Vendor Works

Post Receipt Inspection at consignee site before acceptance of stores:  
By BHEL/TPIA at BHEL Stores

### 3. **Generic**

**Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

### 4. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

### 5. **Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

### 6. **Generic**

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

**3) Delivery Period:** Delivery required by BHEL is **within 90 days** from the date of PO at BHEL-BAP R anipet Stores.

## 4) Payment Term:

**(a) For Micro/Small Enterprises-** 100% payment will be made within 45 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of materials at BHEL Stores /Site.

**(b) For Medium Enterprises:** 100% payment will be made within 60 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of materials at BHEL Stores /Site

**(c) For Non-MSME-** 100% payment will be made within 90 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of materials at BHEL Stores /Site

## 5) Other Terms & Conditions:

- (i) Offers received from bidders meeting the Pre-Qualification Requirements (PQR) shall only be considered. Bidder should submit/Upload the supporting documents called for in the (Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR)). Incomplete bids are liable to be rejected.
- (ii) Vendor shall submit the following documents for BHEL review and clearance of material: Supplier's Test Certificate (TC) as per relevant BHEL Specification, Certificate of Conformance (CoC), and relevant photographs of material similar to those supplied/procured for earlier projects.
- (iii) Deviation, if any, w.r.t **TECHNICAL, QUALITY AND COMMERCIAL** shall be indicated in SPECIFICATION DEVIATION DISPOSITION REPORT (SDDR) only. Deviations indicated in any other documents of the offer shall be ignored and treated as null & void. SDDR duly signed with seal of authorised signatory shall be submitted along with technical bid. NIL report to be submitted in case of NO deviation.
- (iv) BHEL reserves the right to split the quantity of the enquiry as follows: 70% quantity being ordered on the original lowest bidder (L1) and balance 30% on the next higher bidder(s) excluding H1, who accepts the L1 price. In the event that the other than L1 supplier/s do not accept the L1 price, then the balance will be reverted to the original L1 and the original L1 shall be bound to accept the balance of the enquiry quantity kept reserved for order splitting. However, the final decision to split the order rests with BHEL only.
- (v) Payment date shall not be based on the date of invoice. Hence, it is advised that bills are to be sent to BHEL/MM/Purchase - Dealing staff immediately (after dispatch) with complete required documents for processing bills. Seniority of payment shall be based on the date of clearing of bills by BHEL after scrutinising documents like Invoice, LR (original), BG, packing list, Guarantee Certificate, etc as called for in the BHEL Purchase Order and other documents as per law

of land.

- (vi) **INSPECTION / INSPECTION & TESTING AT SUPPLIERS WORKS:**  
BHEL reserves the right to inspect the material during manufacturing and also to get tested the material under dispatch from third party. The test results of third-party test shall be final and binding on the Supplier/Vendor.  
BHEL will reserve the right to inspect/test the material during/after manufacturing at suppliers' works, and/or at BHEL Site. In case of rejection at any stage, Supplier/Vendor shall be liable to replace the materials at his own cost.
- (vii) MSE / MII (Make in India) purchase preference shall be applicable as per GeM T&C. Exemption for MSE & Start-up is for Turnover criteria only. No exemption for MSE & Start-up in experience criteria shall be given and experience criteria is as per tender PQR.
- (viii) Bidder shall submit signed, sealed & dully filled copy of the following documents as a token of confirmation and acceptance for the same.  
(a) Notice Inviting Tender  
(b) Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR)  
(c) BHEL Specification (if any)  
(d) Quality Plan  
(e) Quality documents: Annexure-Q (if applicable)

(h) **Annexure-4:** Declaration regarding Insolvency/ Liquidation/ Bankruptcy Proceedings - may be as part of bid ATC, deviation may be liable for rejection  
(i) **Annexure-11:** Declaration for relation in BHEL: - Unless declared as per format, it shall be treated as bidder has no relation with BHEL. If BHEL Management comes to know at a later date that the information furnished by the Bidder is false, BHEL reserves the right to take suitable action against the Bidder/Contractor.  
(j) MSE Category Declaration
- (ix) Pre-dispatch inspection at Seller premises: Before dispatch, the goods will be inspected by Buyer/BHEL/ Consignee or their Authorized Representative or by Nominated External Inspection Agency (TUV or BVIL /TPI) (independently or jointly with Buyer or jointly with Buyer's End Customer or jointly with End Customer's nominated Agency or Consignee as decided by the Buyer) at Seller premises (or at designated place for inspection as declared / communicated by the seller) for their compliance to the contract specifications. Travel & other local stay cost for the Inspectors sent by BHEL will be to BHEL account, but other Inspection Charges, if any shall be to the account of the Seller only. For in-house testing, the Sellers will provide necessary facilities at free of cost. Seller shall notify the Buyer by 3 days in advance through e-mail about readiness of goods for pre dispatch inspection and also Seller shall register/raise the Inspection call through BHEL CQIR portal <https://cqir.bhel.in/>) for arranging the inspection by BHEL. Buyer/BHEL will notify the Seller about the authorized representative/ Nominated External Inspection Agency and the date for testing. The goods would be dispatched to consignee only after clearance in pre dispatch inspection. Consignee's right of rejection as per GTC in respect of the goods finally received at his location shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by Buyer / Consignee or its Nominated External Inspection Agency prior to the goods' shipment. While bidding, the sellers should take into account 7 days for inspection from the date of email offering the goods for inspection. Any delay in inspection Beyond 7 days shall be on the part of the buyer and shall be regularised without Liquidated Damages.
- (x) **Warranty:** 12 months from the date of commissioning (or) 18 months from the date of supply, whichever is earlier.

- (xi) **Bid Price:** The Bidder has to quote the Landed Price inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, taxes, duties, freight and insurance as specified in tender document.
- (xii) **TRANSIT INSURANCE:** Transit Insurance of material is in Supplier/Vendor's scope. Supplier/Vendor shall insure the material at their cost for transportation.
- (xiii) **MATERIAL DISPATCH CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE (MDCC):**  
MDCC shall be issued by BHEL. No material shall be dispatched by supplier unless and until Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC) issued by BHEL Site. In case any material is dispatched without MDCC and any loss is incurred by Supplier/Vendor for any reason whatsoever, BHEL shall not be responsible in any manner to compensate the supplier in this regard.
- (xiv) **Delay in Delivery:** If the delivery of supply as detailed above gets delayed beyond the delivery period, the Supplier/Vendor shall request for a delivery extension and BHEL at its discretion may extend the Contract. However, if any 'Delivery extension' is granted to the Supplier/Vendor for completion of supply, due to backlog attributable to the Supplier/Vendor, then it shall be without prejudice to the rights of BHEL to impose LD for the delays attributable to the Supplier/Vendor.

In case BHEL increase the quantity during currency of the contract in line with quantity variation clause, delivery extension on pro-rata basis shall be given for supply of these additional quantity.

- (xv) **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED ALONG WITH DISPATCH OF MATERIAL/BILLING DOCUMENTS:**

The following documents are required to be sent with material dispatch/Billing Documents: Original Tax Invoice (3 copies), Copy of LR, Guarantee Certificate.

- (xvi) **Conflict of interest**

The bidder notes that a conflict of interest would said to have occurred in the tender process and execution of the resultant contract, in case of any of the following situations:

- i) If its personnel have a close personal, financial, or business relationship with any personnel of BHEL who are directly or indirectly related to the procurement or execution process of the contract, which can affect the decision of BHEL directly or indirectly;
- ii) The bidder (or his allied firm) provided services for the need assessment/ procurement planning of the Tender process in which it is participating;
- iii) Procurement of goods directly from the manufacturers/ suppliers shall be preferred. However, if the OEM/ Principal insists on engaging the services of an agent, such agent shall not be allowed to represent more than one manufacturer/ supplier in the same tender. Moreover, either the agent could bid on behalf of the manufacturer/ supplier or the manufacturer/ supplier could bid directly but not both. In case bids are received from both the manufacturer/ supplier and the agent, bid received from the agent shall be ignored. However, this shall not debar more than one Authorised distributor (with/ or without the OEM) from quoting equipment manufactured by an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) in procurements under a Proprietary Article Certificate.
- iv) A bidder participates in more than one bid in this tender process. Participation in any capacity by a Bidder (including the participation of a Bidder as a partner/ JV member or sub-contractor in another bid or vice-versa) in more than one bid shall result in the disqualification of all bids in which he is a party. However, this does not limit the participation of an entity as a sub-contractor in more than one bid if he is not bidding independently in his own name or as a member of a JV.

The Bidder declares that they have read and understood the above aspects, and the bidder confirms that such conflict of interest does not exist and undertakes that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s), in this regard. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having i

ndulged in above activities, the same will be considered as a violation of the tender conditions, and suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines

Bidder to indicate to indicate if any of the point (i) to (iv) is applicable or else declare that none is applicable to best of their knowledge.

- (xvii) **MSE CATEGORY DECLARATION-** Any Bidder falling under MSE category shall furnish the details as per attached format & submit documentary evidence/ Govt. Certificate etc. in support of the same along with their techno-commercial offer. If the bidder does not furnish the above in the tender, offer shall be processed construing that the bidder is not falling under MSE category.
- (xviii) **Confidentiality Notice**  
All documents such as specifications, terms and conditions and all correspondence sent to a Seller by BHEL on a tender / order are to be treated as the confidential document of BHEL. All such tender / order-related documents issued by BHEL are to be treated with the same level of confidentiality that the receiver would bestow on their confidential documents. It is to be understood that downloading the documents from the web constitutes the acceptance of this confidentiality clause of BHEL. This provision does not apply to documents freely and is already in the public domain. In their own interest, If any Seller finds or becomes aware of any internal communication of BHEL, in the public domain, it shall be the responsibility of such Seller to bring it to the notice of BHEL for clarification /immediate and appropriate action by BHEL. Any action or attempts taken by a Seller in leveraging such information shall be deemed as an unethical act and shall attract such extant provisions of BHEL's procurement policies.
- (xix) **Material Rejection and Returns**  
If the supplied materials are rejected at our stores, it shall be the responsibility of the supplier to collect the rejected goods from our stores, at their cost and risk, within a reasonable period of 30 days from the date of intimation of the rejection.  
The loading of the rejected goods at BHEL stores onto the vehicles placed by the supplier will be done by BHEL and such loading charges incurred along with the unloading charges incurred by BHEL for the unloading of the rejected goods will be to the account of the supplier. The unloading and loading charges incurred by BHEL will be raised on the supplier and the same shall be deducted from any of the pending bills of the supplier. In case there are no pending bills, the same amount incurred will be recovered from payments due for replacement goods to be supplied by the supplier. Or alternatively, such amounts shall be recovered from the payments due to the supplier, if any, for materials supplied to other BHEL Unit(s).  
If the supplier fails to lift the materials within the stipulated period of 30 days, either the goods will be booked on a freight-to-pay basis to the supplier through any one of the contracted carriers of BHEL and the documents shall be negotiated through bank, or BHEL shall dispose off the rejected materials on their own. The costs incurred for such disposal shall be to the account of the supplier. Where the goods are disposed off, by BHEL, the supplier shall have no claim on whatsoever proceeds that BHEL may get out of such action.
- (xx) **Set Off clause**  
In the event any quantities are pending to be supplied against any purchase order by a seller, subject to the terms and conditions of the order, BHEL reserves the right to account the quantities of the same item supplied in a later order, by the Seller, against the unfulfilled previous order. In such cases of default in the complete execution of an order, BHEL, shall stand authorised at any time, and from time to time, without any prior notice to the Seller, to set off and apply any and all supplies made against the current order to the account of the previously issued purchase order of the same item.
- (xxi) **Order of Precedence:**  
In the event of any ambiguity or conflict between the Tender Documents, the order of precedence shall be in the order below:  
a. Amendments/Clarifications/Corrigenda/Errata etc. issued in respect of the tender documents by BHEL.  
b. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC  
c. GeM Bid / Technical Conditions of Contract (TCC) / GeM GTC

(xxii) **Acceptance to the Enquiry Conditions**

Submission of an offer against our tender Enquiry, shall constitute the unconditional acceptance of all terms and conditions set forth in the Enquiry sheet, by the bidder, including the applicable general terms and conditions, special terms and conditions, specifications, technical delivery conditions, and all other documents forming part of the tender Enquiry, unless the bidder has indicated a specific deviation. Any such deviation must be clearly stated and duly signed and sealed by the bidder.

- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.
