If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 5. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.
7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

### 2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- The bidders shall submit RC copy of the owned vehicle (Sedan) in the name of the service provider. Valid comprehensive insurance must be provided for the vehicle for the contract period. A valid Fitness Certificate as per RTO norms is mandatory. Vendor must submit PAN and GST registration certificates. Experience certificate or proof of past government/PSU contracts may be submitted except for bidders validly registered under the MSE category.
- The rate shall be inclusive of driver, fuel and lubricants etc. The maximum kilometre to run per month as mention in the schedule. For any extra Km than mention in the schedule shall be paid under prescribed item.
- The timing for operation of the vehicle shall be 9 hours (i.e. 9.00 AM to 6.00 PM.) Extra rate shall be payable beyond 9 hours(8+1) a day as per prescribed item
- In no case, actual wages paid to the workers shall be less than that as stipulated by ministry of labour by state or central government, whichever is higher. All local labour laws shall be strictly followed. Any complaints received in this regard and proved for shall be taken seriously and appropriate action under relevant clause of the agreement shall be taken.
- If any claim received due to not attending the complaints/instructions, the damage will be borne by the contractor.
- In case of non-attendance on any working day, the amount shall be deducted for the same.
- All type of repairs shall be carried out by the owner of the vehicle at his own cost.
- The vehicle should have proper air conditioning and should be maintained in neat and clean condition.
- A daily record indicating time and mileage for the vehicle shall be maintained in a log book.
- All the journey performed, covered on account of filling of fuel / repair and by the driver during his halt at out station from headquarter i.e.at his residence / place of parking and back from there to the Headquarter shall not be paid by the department.
- Hire charges include monthly charges of driver, running of vehicle, repairs and maintenance of vehicle, insurance, Diesel/c Lubricant up to 2000 Km. per month and also any other incidental expenses including penalty, fine, traffic challan etc. shall be borne by the Agency. Nothing shall be paid extra on such accounts. However, for every additional / less Km. beyond / below the specified Km in the schedule per month shall be paid / deducted respectively as per rate quoted in the schedule of quantity.
- In case of any breakdown/damage / theft /accident, the owner of vehicle will provide equivalent substitute vehicle immediately otherwise a penalty of Rs. 1000/- per day will be imposed and the recovery of same will be made from the monthly running bill.
- In case of any accident, all the claims arising out of it shall be met by the Vehicle Owner Agency . The owner of the Vehicle shall be responsible for compensation payable arising out of accident pa

- yment to third party, if warranted. No compensation in case of accident / damage to Vehicle or for death / injury to the driver will be made by the department.
14. 14. In case of loss of property of department is caused due to the negligence on the part of the driver of vehicle, such losses shall be borne by the contractor.
  15. 15. The vehicle will be kept neat and clean in perfect running condition by the Vehicle Owner.
  16. 16. The driver should have a valid driving license and the vehicle should be registered with the concerned authority of Central/State Govt. A certificate to this effect should be provided. 17. The driver of the vehicle must follow traffic rules and other regulations prescribed herein on any day.
  17. 18. The contract between the department and the contractor can be cancelled with a notice period of 15 days by Contractor or by the department.
  18. 19. The driver shall observe all the etiquette and protocol while performing the duty. He shall be neatly dressed, should wear white colour uniform and shall carry a mobile phone in working condition, for which, nothing shall be paid extra by the department.
  19. 20. The Vehicle shall have two sets of loose white seat covers for alternative use and shall be changed every 4 days or whenever required. Cost of cleaning of the same will be borne by the owner of the Vehicle. The Vehicle shall be kept neat and clean and in perfect running condition with adequate quantity of fuel and should be provided with neat and clean seat covers / towels and there should be sufficient space in the dicky to keep the luggage.
  20. 21. Toll Tax, Entry Tax at Barrier, other state's Road Taxes and Parking Fees shall be reimbursed as per actual expenses.
  21. 22. If the vehicle remains absent, due to any reason, whatsoever, the controlling officer reserves the right to hire another vehicle from the market for that day and the hire charges shall be recovered from the Contractor or the Contractor shall arrange alternate vehicle on such situation at his risk and cost.
  22. Repairs, if any shall be borne by the Contractor and the department will not be responsible for any repairs and maintenance.
  23. 23. All expenditure incurred on the vehicle in running (including fuel charges etc.), maintenance, repair or repair due to any accident, shall be borne by the owner/contractor. Nothing extra shall be paid on any account.
  24. 24. The distance covered from garage to the office and back from office to garage etc. shall not be paid.
  25. 25. The driver shall have a decent & polite behaviour. If the Engineer-in-charge is not satisfied with the behaviour of the Driver, the agency shall change the driver. Nothing extra will be paid for the same.
  26. 26. Any fine due to traffic violation shall be the liability of the owner/ contractor. Nothing shall be paid / borne by the department.
  27. 27. Arrangement of the different driver will be responsibility of the owner/ contractor so that driver is available on all days including Sundays and Holidays. Change of driver will not be allowed unless exceptional / unavoidable circumstances arise without permission of Engineer-in-Charge.
  28. 28. Department shall reserve the right to cancel the tender without any reason told in the interest of government.
  29. Road Tax, Insurance shall be borne by the Contractor and nothing extra will be paid on this account.
  30. 29. All vehicles provided shall have all the necessary permits/licenses/clearances such as, but not limited to fitness certificate, PUC, full comprehensive insurance, road permit, registration certificate, as per the Motor Vehicles Act, RTO and other applicable laws and statutory bodies, for providing commercial vehicles for this service.
  31. 30. All vehicles should be in excellent working condition (both internally and externally) at all times. The contractor shall ensure that the vehicles deployed by him are cleaned thoroughly both internally and externally, boot kept clear of dust, rubbish, oil, bad odour and any personal belongings of the driver.
  32. 31. The drivers of the vehicles must possess a valid driver license and must have a minimum 2 years of driving experience.
  33. The Contractor shall ensure that all maintenance works related to the assigned vehicle will be carried out in off duty hours. It shall be ensured that all electrical connections including lights (both brake and front), horn, turn indicators, air conditioning and other vehicle systems shall be periodically checked and maintained by Vehicle owner to avoid any inconvenience to the Engineer-in-charge.

### 3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

## अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
