If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

3. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods

4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Along with the GeM technical specifications, additional specification required for HDPE tarpaulins to be used as dunnage by the buyer are listed below-

Description: Good quality HDPE Tarpaulin having minimum 200 GSM

Dimensions of the tarpaulin: tarpaulin must measure **not less than 20.5 ft x 30.5 ft (6.2484 m X 9.2964 m)**

A tolerance limit of +0.5 ft in the required dimension of tarpaulin of 20.5 ft x 30.5 ft shall be permissible for consideration but no negative tolerance shall be acceptable.

Type based on mass, in g/m²: **Minimum 200 GSM**

Only BIS Marked Catalogs should be supplied

Usage: For stacking bags containing foodgrains

Governing Standard: As per BIS specification and Governing Standard IS 7903:2017 (latest)

Eyelets material and **fixing**: Metallic eyelets at minimum four corners. Size 28 of IS 4084 or 30 IS 4084

Hemming: Heat sealing or lock type double stitching

Quantity: **Approx. 90 pieces i.e., 5229 sq m in total with 7 pieces i.e., 407 sq m for FSD Ashoknagar and 83 pieces i.e., 4822 sq m for FSD OJM** are required. The quantity may be changed according to the lowest bid price to match the budgetary provision as per the instructions of the Competent Authority.

Guarantee: The product shall be guaranteed against deterioration in quality for a period of one year from the date of receipt of consignment

Additional Terms and conditions:

1. The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25 % of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates.

2. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly. The rate per piece of HDPE Tarpaulin of required specification should be quoted including tax and all other charges.

3. All loading/ unloading charges, taxes as applicable, transportation/ other incidental charges etc. will have to be borne by the successful bidder for which no separate remuneration will be provided.

4. Tarpaulin must measure not less than 20.5 ft x 30.5 ft (6.2484 m X 9.2964 m). A tolerance limit of +0.5 ft in the required dimension of tarpaulin of 20.5 ft x 30.5 ft shall be permissible for consideration but no negative tolerance shall be acceptable.

5. The bidder shall submit advance sample(s) of the finished tarpaulin product to the Consignee(s) for approval within the stipulated period commencing from the date of bid publication and up to the technical bid opening. Submission of such sample by the bidder and approval of such sample(s) by the consignee shall be mandatory for the bid to be considered for technical evaluation. The bidders who will be unable to sub

mit advance sample within the time frame or their sample(s) is rejected, their technical bid will be summarily rejected in technical evaluation. All samples required for test shall be supplied by the successful bidder free of cost.

6. The successful bidder has to demonstrate on his own capacity the specification of the dunnage as required by the buyer during the supply of samples and bulk supply.

7. In case the samples do not meet the requirements desired by the buyer, the same needs to be replaced within 7 days otherwise storage charge @ Rs. 100/day/dunnage will be applicable.

8. The successful bidder is liable to deliver **90 pieces i.e., 5229 sq m in total with 7 pieces i.e., 407 sq m for FSD Ashoknagar and 83 pieces i.e., 4822 sq m for FSD OJM** of HDPE Tarpaulin as per the given specifications within 15 days of acceptance of contract, only after approval of advance sample. The Corporation reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity without assigning any reason thereof at the time of acceptance of the contract or during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

9. The bulk supplied material will be checked at the time of delivery by the Manager (Depot)/ In-charge or any officer acting on his behalf and should be complied with the sample approved by this office and other specifications as per terms and conditions of the contract.

10. In case the material received at destination is found defective, damaged, and short or not as per the specification, the same should be replaced by successful bidder free of cost within 7 days.

11. **Security deposit:** A sum of **Rs.10,000 (Ten thousand)** needs to be deposited upon the award of contract in SBI, A/C NO-11175232102, IFSC Code- SBIN0001401, within 04 (four) working days of award of Tender by FCI. Time period of depositing of the total amount is not extendable. In the event of the Tenderer's failure, after the communication of acceptance of the tender by the Corporation, to deposit balance amount, his/her Contract shall be summarily terminated and the Corporation shall proceed for appointment of another contractor. Any losses or damages arising out of and incurred by the Corporation by such conduct of the contractor will be recovered from the contractor, without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of the Corporation under the Contract and Law.

12. **Delay Charges:** If the seller is unable to deliver the required items within the delivery time as per the GeM contract, then delay charges @ **Rs.300/ day** will be admissible to be deducted from the bill of the seller in case extension of delivery date is approved by the competent authority over and above any other such charges mandated by GeM and / or other statutory or other mandates.

13. The claims for fire, shortage damages, any other unforeseen contingencies, if any shall be settled directly by the bidder with the Insurance Company.

14. No advance payment in any case would be made. Payment will be made on submission of bill along with satisfactory completion of the contract order as certified by the concerned consignee, i.e. Manager (Depot)/In-charge.

15. The successful bidder will not have any legal right to proceed against FCI in the event of late payments due to unforeseen reason(s). If the successful bidder fails to supply the items within the stipulated time, alternate arrangements will be made from this office for the supply of the said items at the risk and cost of the defaulter and he will be liable for recovery of loss suffered by the Corporation.

16. The Divisional Manager, FCI, DO 24 Parganas reserves the right to accept or reject any or all responses and to request additional submissions or clarification from one or more Bidder at any stage or to cancel the entire process without assigning any reason and without any legal obligation thereof. The Corporation makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, as to the accuracy, correctness and completeness of the information contained in the quotation.

17. The Divisional Manager, FCI, DO 24 Parganas reserves the right to accept or

reject any or all bidders without assigning any reasons thereof and without any legal obligation thereafter.

18. The Successful E-Bid Party/ Supplier has **to supply the sample and the required quantity of HDPE Tarpaulins** to the below mentioned address within the time period as mandated above:

19. The payment will be made through RTGS/ NEFT Transfer on submission of bill through GeM Portal and certified by respective consignee, i.e. Manager (Depot)/In charge.

20. Intending quotationer(s) shall have and upload along with the quotation a valid license copy of self-attested Trade License, GST Registration Certificate, Copy of AADHAAR, PAN Card, MSME Certificate (if available), Bank details, Income Tax return acknowledgements for the FY 2023-24 (AY 2024-25) and FY 2024-25 (AY 2025-26).

21. The offered rates should be quoted per piece including GST and all other incidentals. The rate will include all other charges like transportation, handling etc. up to point of delivery. FCI reserves the right to accept the L1 (lowest Quoted Rate) rate. But it is not binding upon the FCI to accept L1 rate, FCI shall have the right to accept or reject L1 rate or scrap the tender without assigning any reasons or prior notice.

22. Liquidated Damages:[GEM point 15(iii)]:-If the Seller fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed Delivery/Time period(s) specified in the Contract, the Purchaser will be also entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions, @ 0.5% per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 5% of the contract value without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

23. Termination for default:(GEM point 19):If the Seller does not perform their obligations under the Contract within the Delivery Period/Date stipulated in the Contract, the same would constitute the breach of the Contract and the Purchaser shall have the right to Cancel/withdraw the Contract for the unsupplied portion after the expiry of the original/re-fixed delivery date/period stipulated in the Contract. Such cancellation on account of non-performance by the Seller would entitle the Purchaser to forfeit the Performance Security Bank Guarantee in whole or in part, if applicable, apart from their downgraded ratings or debarment from the GeM.

24. Force Majeure:[GEM point 15(iv)]:- If at any time during the continuance of the Contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this Contract shall be prevented or delayed by the reasons of any war, hostility, acts of the public enemy, epidemics, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosion, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God provided notice of happening of such event duly evidenced with documents is given by one party to the other within 10 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall be by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate the Contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or the delay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of the Purchaser as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive, Provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 10 days, either party may at its option terminate the contract provided also that the purchaser shall be at liberty to take over from the Seller at a price to be fixed by Purchaser, which shall be final, all unused, undamaged and accepted mat

erial, bought out components and stores in course of manufacture in the possession of the Seller at the time of such termination or such portion thereof as the Purchaser may deem fit excepting such materials, bought out components and stores as the Seller may with the concurrence of the Purchaser elect to retain.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working

Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.
