1. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) from the State of Bid Inviting Authority : Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as Micro and Small Enterprises from the State of Bid inviting Authority. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 100 % of total quantity as defined/ decided in relevant policy.

2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to

minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

- 1) All the bidders are invited to participate in the tender for DWC Pipes. Manufacturers or their authorized dealers are eligible to participate in the tender. The **FINANCIAL OFFER** of the prospective participant in the tender will be considered only if the **TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS** of the participant in the tender is found qualified by the KMC authority. The decision of the KMC Authority will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of Qualified Bidders will be displayed before opening of financial offer.

2) Terms and conditions for participating in the tender.

All intending participant in the tender who qualifies in the eligibility criteria for the purpose of DWC Pipe should also fulfill the following additional terms & condition. If any of the participants in the tender fails to fulfill any of the terms & conditions mentioned below, that particular tender will be declared informal/non-responsive.

- I. Manufacturers as well as dealers of DWC pipes are eligible to participate in the tender.
- II. Certificate to ensure that the pipe manufacturing capacity of the factory is sufficient to cater to the tendered requirement i.e. capacity should not be less than the tendered quantity.
- III. Bonafide and Established DWC pipe Manufacturers should produce valid BIS certification of manufacturers as on date of publication of tender for each and individual size of pipe tendered.
- IV. In case of authorized dealers the authorization certificate along with valid BIS of the manufacturer has to be submitted.
- V. Participant in the tender should produce valid PAN issued by the IT Department, Govt. of India. 15 digit Goods & Services tax payer's identification number (GSTIN) under GST Act 2007, Latest P.T. deposit challan & Certificate, Balance sheet & ITR for last 2 years.
- VI. Trade license will be mandatory for those whose manufacturing unit is located within the jurisdiction of KMC.
- VII. Third party inspection (TPI) through CIPET/RITES/MECON/EIL/PDIL of pipe is mandatory before delivery of pipe. The inspection charges are to be included in the quoted rate. No additional cost will be provided.
- VIII. The sampling size will be guided by the relevant IS Code.
- IX. Specification: Detail Specification has been furnished in the item description.
- X. a) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of a similar nature of completed work of the minimum value of 30% (Thirty percent) of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice;

Or,

b) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of 2(two) similar nature of completed work, each of the minimum value of 25% (Twenty Five percent) of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice;

Or,

c) Intending tenderers should produce credentials of one single running work of similar nature which has been completed to the extent of 75% (Seventy Five percent) or more and value of which is not less than the desired value at (a) above;

In case of running works, only those tenderers who will submit the certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e., the tenderer.

- XI. **Similar** work means supply of any kind of Pipes.
- XII. Credential certificate issued by Executive engineer or equivalent or competent authority of a State/Central Government, State/Central Government undertaking, Statutory/Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central/State statute, on the executed value of completed/running work will be taken as credential.
- XIII. **Summation of phased order issued against a single tender will be considered as a single work.**

XIV. Payment Certificate will not be treated as credential;

- 3) A declaration in the form of an affidavit on stamp paper of Rs. 10/-, duly attested by a Notary should be submitted as per format given in the Proforma I, stating that the applicant is not debarred or blacklisted or delisted in any way at any Govt. / Semi- Govt. /Autonomous Body/ Govt. institution in India on the date of submission of the tender.
- 4) The eligibility of a bidder will be ascertained on the basis of the document(s) in support of the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Clause 2 & 3 above. If any document submitted by a bidder is either manufactured or false, in such cases the eligibility of the bidder / participant in the tender will be rejected at any stage without any prejudice. In that case the bidder may be debarred from participating in any tender by Kolkata Municipal Corporation in future.
- 5) Payment will be made as per GEM rules.
- 6) Whenever the contracts are rescinded the security deposits shall be forfeited.
- 7) The successful bidder, will have to provide security deposit, worth 5% as per GEM.
- 8) The price preference will be governed by the notification vide no. 10500-F of West Bengal Financial Rule (WBFR) issued by Govt. of West Bengal Finance Department, Audit Branch.
- 9) Offer shall remain valid for a period of 365 days from the date of opening of tender for acceptance. Once accepted, the offer should remain valid for full financial year or 365 days from the date of opening of tender whichever is later. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the validity period of bid, the SD money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.
- 10) Supply must strictly be completed within the delivery period mentioned in the purchase order failing which order may be cancelled and the Department may take appropriate action accordingly by forfeiting SD and debarring the company for participating in any tender of KMC for specified time period.
- 11) If any material is found defective after supply, the same is to be replaced free of cost.
- 12) Only approved materials will be accepted. In case of failure for more than three occasions, the PO may be cancelled and the vendor may be debarred from participating in the subsequent tender of KMC for a minimum period of three calendar years
- 13) There shall be no provision of Arbitration.
- 14) The intending Bidders should clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the Department. The KMC authority reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Participant in the tender at the stage of Bidding.
- 15) Conditional / Incomplete tender will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 16) The appropriate authority of Kolkata Municipal Corporation, reserves the right to cancel the tender due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 17) Quoted price should include all statutory payments imposed by State & Central Govt. Escalation of Price on any ground and consequent cost overrun shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Rates should be quoted accordingly. The bidder has to submit the breakups if asked for.
- 18) If the dates fall on holidays or on days of bandh or natural calamity, the dates defer to next working days.
- 19) KMC reserves the right to award the contract part or full or to cancel the contract without assigning any reason thereof.
- 20) **The length of the pipes must be supplied in standard size available in market.**
- 21) **Signed copy of ATC is to be mandatorily uploaded as a testimony of acceptance of all terms & conditions put up in the Bid document.**
