If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
5. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) from the State of Bid Inviting Authority : Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as Micro and Small Enterprises from the State of Bid inviting Authority. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 25 % of total quantity as defined/ decided in relevant policy.
7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Buyer should verify the validity of FSSAI license of Original Product producer/OEM/Retail supplier at the time of supply.
2. Buyer should also verify the expiry of the product and ensure that it is well within the residual shelf life period mentioned in the product specification.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity ÷ Original quantity) × Original delivery period (in days), subject to

minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

Terms and Conditions

1. The firm must be registered under GST and shall submit a valid GST Registration Certificate.
2. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) must be submitted in original at the Office of the Nodal Officer (Procurement), Directorate of Health Services, Sri Vijayapuram, at least one day prior to the opening of the bid. A scanned copy of the EMD must also be uploaded at the time of bidding.
3. EMD and turnover requirements are not applicable to MSMEs and Startups, subject to submission of valid MSME/Startup Registration Certificates.
4. The ration items shall be supplied on a monthly basis, as and when required, strictly as per the Purchase Order issued by the Directorate of Health Services.
5. Monthly bills must be submitted to the concerned Medical Officer (In-Charge) of the respective PHC where the items have been supplied.
6. Scanned copy of EMDs @ 3% of the estimated cost that is **1,485** in the form of Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/FDR/TDR/Insurance Security Bonds etc. from Nationalized/Scheduled bank drawn in favour of "Assistant Accounts Officer, DHS, Sri Vijaya Puram". The EMD of the successful bidder will be kept with the buyer till completion of the contract.

Supply and Delivery Conditions

6. The supplier shall be fully responsible for any loss or damage during transit and shall ensure safe delivery of the goods/stores in good condition to the concerned PHC under the Directorate of Health Services, A & N Administration.
7. The quantity of items may increase or decrease at the time of issuing the Purchase Order depending upon actual requirements, up to an extent of $\pm 2.5\%$.
8. The quality and quantity of the items delivered shall be verified and accepted by the Medical Officer (In-Charge) of the concerned PHC.
9. The successful supplier shall supply the items on an "as and when required basis" upon receipt of indent from the Medical Officer (In-Charge) of the co

ncerned PHC.

10. The tenderer shall not sublet, assign, or entrust the work to any other agency or person.

Contract and Payment Conditions

11. Any offer made in response to this tender, when accepted by the Directorate of Health Services, shall constitute a binding contract between the parties.
12. In case of failure to deliver the items on the scheduled date, a penalty of 0.5% of the value of the delayed items per day shall be levied, subject to a maximum penalty of 10% of the total value of the indented items.
13. In case any bidder quotes abnormally low or high rates for individual items, such bids may be rejected outright. The rate reasonability will be assessed by the Purchase Committee, and the purchaser is not liable to provide justification to the tenderer.
14. The contract shall be valid for a period of one (01) year from the date of execution of the agreement and may be extended for a further period of one (01) year based on satisfactory performance and mutual consent.
15. The service provider shall not be entitled to any increase in the approved rates during the contract period.

Eligibility and General Conditions

16. The tenderer must have a registered shop within the State/UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands with a valid registration number. The complete address and contact details must be clearly mentioned in the tender document.
17. The Directorate of Health Services reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations, either fully or partially, without assigning any reason whatsoever.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum

issued by DPIIT in this regard.

2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.
