1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

3. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

4. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

5. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

6. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

7. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

The following terms and conditions are applicable for the all items.

1. Bidders may please note that GeM is capturing and showing the IP addresses used by the Buyer and the Bidder(s) /Seller(s). The received bids having matching/common IP address with either Bidder (s)/ Seller(s) or Buyer, shall be outrightly rejected & shall not be considered for further evaluation.

2. PDI: Pre-Dispatch inspection of all items shall be carried out by NTPC RIO at vendor's work as per NTPC approved SQP.

After receipt of Purchase Order, vendor shall raise inspection call online through URL <https://teamup.ntpcclerkshya.co.in> Help document for viewing approved documents & raising inspection call is provided in the given URL.

After successful PDI, vendor has to submit Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC) issued by NTPC RIO along with supply.

3. Payment Term: As per GeM GTC

4. Guarantee/ Warranty certificate: 18 months from the date of dispatch or 12 months from the date of commissioning, whichever is earlier).

5. Bidders who will submit "UDYAM REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE", shall only be eligible for MSE benefits/ purchase preference. Bidder(s) who will submit any other documents e.g. NSIC etc., will not be eligible for MSE purchase preference/ benefit.

In case of tenders where splitting of quantity is not possible, participating MSEs quoting price within price band of L1 + 15 percent shall be allowed to execute the package by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a Micro and Small Enterprise. The award shall be made as follows:

(i) Award shall be given to L1 bidder if L1 bidder is a MSE.

(ii) In case L1 bidder is not a MSE, then all the MSE vendor(s) who have quoted within the range of L1 + 15 %, shall be given the opportunity to bring down its price to match with L1 bidder. MSE Preference:

In case of tenders where splitting of quantity is not possible, participating MSEs quoting price within price band of L1 + 15 percent shall be allowed to execute the package by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a Micro and Small Enterprise. The award shall be made as follows:

(i) Award shall be given to L1 bidder if L1 bidder is a MSE.

(ii) In case L1 bidder is not a MSE, then all the MSE vendor(s) who have quoted within the range of L1 + 15 %, shall be given the opportunity to bring down its price to match with L1 bidder. The award shall be placed on the MSE vendor who matches the price quoted by L1 bidder subject to following order of MSE preference.

MSE Preference:

In case of procurement of goods / services, preferences to MSEs whose quoted prices are within L1 (non-MSEs) +15% range (subject to matching of L1 price) will be given in the following order:

The MSE order quantity will be as per following:

Further, eligible MSE and/or Class-I local supplier as per the provisions specified in the Bidding documents with respect to MSE Benefit/Purchase Preferences shall be offered to match the Negotiated/ Awardable price of L-1 Bidder in the order of their ranking & eligibility based on Original quoted price of L-1 Bidder (before Negotiation)."

6. MII document/ declaration shall be submitted along with the bid as per GeM Bid terms and conditions.

(a). MII document/ declaration shall be issued from OEM (Original equipment's manufacturer) on OEM's letterhead only else offer shall be liable for rejection/ MII purchase preference shall not be given.

(b) Minimum 60 % Local Content required for qualifying as Class 1 Local Supplier.

Bidder shall submit MII declaration clearly mentioning with BID NO, % Local content, place of addition of local content. The document shall be duly signed by OEM.

7. Nil Deviation:- "The sellers who participate in current Tender are deemed to have fully accepted all Terms & Conditions, Technical Specifications, Delivery Days, Data Sheets, Drawings, Quality Plans, Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions given in Bidding Documents, read in conjunction with Amendment(s)/ Clarification(s)/ Addenda/ Errata (if any) issued by the Buyer prior to opening of Techno-Commercial Bids,

and the same are supposed to have been taken into consideration while making their Techno-Commercial Bid & Price Bid. Further it is construed that no deviation has been taken by the seller in this regard.

9. If non enlisted/rejected vendors are interested to participate, can do so in future tenders first by enlisting themselves for the respective product category (MEG). They shall have to visit NTPC CPC website www.vendor.ntpc.co.in and submit online application against items/services (Material /Contract Enlistment Groups) of their choice. If they meet the criteria stipulated in the Qualifying Requirement, they shall be enlisted in line with the Terms and Conditions of enlistment.

10. "The enlistment of the bidders should be valid as on either the date of issue of NIT or the actual date of bid opening. "

Liquidated Damages : If the Seller fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

12. Post Bid Clarification:

· In the event subsequent clarification(s)/query(ies) by NTPC are sought from Bidder and bidder fails to respond or responds with incorrect / inadequate or non-compliant information, the bid shall be liable to be rejected.

· During techno-commercial evaluation of offer, reply given by bidder against the queries/clarifications asked and further accepted by NTPC shall be an integral part of the GeM Contract. Contract shall be executed in accordance with the same.

2. Stamp paper of appropriate value shall be purchased in the name of guarantee issuing bank or the part

y on whose behalf the BG is being issued. **The Bank Guarantee shall be issued on non-judicial Stamp paper of appropriate value as per Stamp act prevailing in the States where the BG is to be submitted (Chhattisgarh in case of EMD) OR is to be acted upon (State where concerned plant/Unit is situated - Only for PBG) OR the rate prevailing in the state where the BG is executed (State where BG issuing Bank branch is situated), whichever is higher.**

16. In the event of Suppliers failure to supply the material of acceptable quality in scheduled delivery period, NTPC reserves the right to procure the materials from any other source at the Suppliers risk and cost and the difference in cost shall be borne by the Supplier. Further, NTPC shall retain the right of forfeiture of CPG and or any other action as deemed fit.

17. Conflict of Interest

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Employer's interests. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a. they directly or indirectly control, or are controlled by or are under common control of another entity; or
- b. they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of their bids; or
- c. they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third party(ies), that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
- d. Bidder and/or any of its allied entity(ies), which directly or indirectly control(s) or is(are) controlled by or is(are) under common control of another entity, has(ve) participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the tender; or
- e. Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process.
- f. In cases of agents quoting on behalf of their principal manufacturers/service providers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers/service providers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer/service provider can also authorize only one agent. There can be only one bid from the full

owing:

- i. The principal manufacturer/service provider directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
- ii. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal.

For the purposes of this clause the term 'control' shall have the following meaning:

"Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions exercisable by a person or persons acting individually or in concert, directly or indirectly, including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders' agreements or voting agreements or in any other manner.

Note: If two or more CPSEs/State PSEs participate in a tender, they will not be deemed to fall under the 'Conflict of Interest' provisions solely because they are under common control of Government of India/State Government.

In case it is established that we have provided any false information in pursuance of the aforesaid Clause, while competing for this contract, then our bid shall be rejected and bid security shall be forfeited.

We also understand that in case we become successful bidder, if it is established that we have not complied with terms of aforesaid Clause as mentioned under Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC, during execution of contract, this would be considered as fraudulent practice as mentioned in para 5.1 (j) of Policy for Debarment from Business Dealings and shall be dealt accordingly. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
