4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Mode of Tender: Open.

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:

Commercial Terms & Conditions: -

I. Price Basis: - Variable as per PV clause mentioned in "General Terms and Conditions".

2) PRICE BID DISCLOSURE:

If any price component related to subject NIT in full or in part is exposed and found with its techno commercial offers, the offer shall out rightly be rejected and will not be considered further.

3) TAXES & DUTIES: As applicable at per actual.

4)Payment Terms: -

i. 95% of contract price shall be made against monthly RA bills after statutory deductions as applicable subject to satisfactory completion of the job duly certified by the Officer-in-charge and execution of the agreement.

ii. Remaining 5% payment will be released after completion of the contract.

Payment will be done in Non-GeM Mode i.e. offline mode.

Payment will be done on RA bill certified by DGM/Sr. Manager, PWS, KTPS, DVC subject to satisfactory completion of the work.

The contractor shall raise the bill on completion of every month, which should be duly certified by the officer In-charge and the payment shall be done as per above payment term.

5) BOQ:

As per attached BOQ.

6)PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BID:

(i) Bids shall remain valid for a period of 180 days from the closing date prescribed by the Employer for the receipt of bids. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Employer as being nonresponsive.

(ii) In exceptional circumstances, the Employer may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the bid validity period. The request and responses thereto shall be made by e-mail. If a Bidder accepts to extend the period of bid validity, the validity of bid security shall also be suitably extended. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A Bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its bid.

7) CONTRACT PERIOD:

The contract shall remain valid for a period of Seven Hundred & Thirty (730) Days from the date of commencement of the work order.

The contract may be terminated within the contract period if performance is found unsatisfactory in the opinion of DVC, without showing any further reason.

8) IMPORTANT TERMS & CONDITIONS:

(a) Invoice to be raised separately with different rates of GST.

(b) Please submit Tax Invoice on supply of material/ service with prerequisites statutory information within stipulated time as mentioned in the relevant provisions of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act 2017 and allied acts and rules made thereunder. In case the invoice is issued beyond the stipulated time as per GST Act, then DVC will not be liable to reimburse any such taxes & duties paid under the GST Act. Further, the supplier of Goods/ Services indemnifies DVC from and against any loss / extra cost incurred by the company on account of default by the supplier or any of its third party in any statutory compliance of the GST Act.

9) AGREEMENT:

An agreement in DVC's prescribed format (Enclosed with the BID) shall be executed by the contractor on a non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100.00 (Rupees One Hundred) only.

Contract agreement shall be executed after receipt and verification of the requisite performance security (wherever applicable). The said agreement will be duly signed by the authorized representative of DVC and authorized signatory of Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant.

The Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant should acknowledge and unconditionally accept, sign, date and return the agreement within 14 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of OTE. Such acknowledgements may not be required in low value contract, below Rupees Two and a Half Lakh or when the bidders offer has been accepted in entirety, without any modifications. If both parties simultaneously sign the contract across the table, further acknowledgement from the supplier is not required.

Non- execution of Contract Agreement by the Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider within 30 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of OTE and 45 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order in case of GTE, due to the fault of the Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider, will constitute sufficient ground for forfeiture of its EMD (wherever applicable) and shall short close the Contract and retender and in this retender such defaulting Bidder will not be allowed to participate.

10) LD CLAUSE & Risk purchase clause:

I. DVC reserves the right to recover a sum equivalent to 0.5% of the delayed work for each week of delay or part thereof subject to maximum of 5% of the total value of the order as Liquidated Damage due to delay

in completion of work attributable to the contractor.

II. Alternatively, the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase the service from elsewhere at the sole risk and cost of the Vendor and recover all such extra cost incurred by the Purchaser in procuring the service by the above procedure.

III. Alternatively, the Purchaser may cancel the Order completely or partly without prejudice to his right under the alternatives mentioned above.

IV. In the event of recourse to alternative (ii) and (iii) above, the Purchaser will have the right to repurchase the service, to meet urgency in requirement caused by Vendors failure to comply with the schedule of delivery irrespective of the fact whether the materials are similar or not.

11) Penalty Clause:

(a) If the contractor fails to provide the vehicle(s) on a particular day then a penalty of Rs. 3000/- for whole day or part thereof (Hourly basis) will be deducted from monthly bill.

(b) As per Engineer-in-charge/authorized representative instruction, if any owner refuses/deny sending Vehicle(s) to any place in W.B, Jharkhand, Bihar, on interest of corporation work a penalty of Rs 1000/- will be deducted from running monthly bill.

12) LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:

Except in cases of Criminal Negligence or wilful misconduct,

(i) The Contractor and The Employer shall not be liable to the Other Party for any indirect or consequential loss or damage, loss of use, loss of production, or loss of profits or Interest costs, provided that this exclusion shall not apply to any obligation of the Contractor to pay liquidated damages to the Employer

AND

(ii) The aggregate liability of the Contractor to the Employer, whether under the Contract, in tort or otherwise, shall not exceed the total Contract Price, provided that this limitation shall not apply to the cost of repairing or replacing defective equipment, or to any obligation of the Contractor to indemnify the Employer with respect to patent infringement, copy right, workman compensation.

13) SECURITY DEPOSIT -CUM -PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

Security Deposit shall be recovered through pro-rata deduction at the rate of 3% from each Running Account (RA) Bill, which will be released after successful completion of the contract.

14) TERMINATION OF CONTRACT: It will be guided as per relevant clause of GCC. "GCC 2023" is available in DVC website www.dvc.gov.in. Also attached here in.

15) SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES & ARBITRATION: It will be guided as per GCC. GCC' 2023 is available in DVC website www.dvc.gov.in.

16)VENDOR BILL TRACKING SYSTEM:

The Vendor Bill Tracking system is active & available at <https://application.dvc.gov.in/Vendor/> (under PROCUREMENT tab of DVC homepage <https://www.dvc.gov.in/>).

The Vendors on award of contract need to register themselves & submit their contract related bills online. After submission of the bill, a cover letter containing unique bill ID shall be generated which must be submitted to DVC along with other payment related documents in hardcopy.

17)SUB-LETTING:

Sub-letting is not allowed in this contract.

18)GOVERNING LAW(CLAUSE NO.30 OF GCC DVC): The Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with laws in force in India. The Courts of Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the Contract

19)FORCE MAJEURE: As Per the Clause 16 of the DVC's GCC.

20)CONTROLLING OFFICER: The Sr. Manager (PWS),or their authorized representative.

21)EPF/ESIC:

Compliance of EPF & ESI scheme for the workers engaged by the Contractor shall be applicable as per rules. EPF & ESI provision shall have to be made by the contractor as per prevailing rules and the same to be in force from time to time during the tenure of the contract. The liability to comply with all related formalities shall rest upon the contractor.

22)SAFETY CLAUSE: As per GCC. GCC' 2023 is available in DVC website www.dvc.gov.in.

23) SPECIAL INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS:

I. Status of organization (i.e. Company Registration Certificate/ Memorandum and Article of Association/ Partnership Deed / sole-proprietorship as the case may be) with documentary evidence. Upload the scan copy of same during the bid submission.

II. MSME certificate/ NSIC Registration certificate from appropriate government authority (as & if applicable). Upload the scan copy of same during the bid submission.

III. PAN,GST Registration certificate, Bank account details . Upload the scan copy of same during the bid submission.

IV. The bidder must have a valid EPF and ESI registration Certificate. Upload the scan copy of same during the bid submission.

V. Quotation received after due date may not be considered. If you submit more than one offer against the GeM Bid within the due date, the latest offer received against the NIT at this office may only be taken into consideration. Unsolicited offers will not be considered.

VI. The bidders are requested to download the format of Letter of Bid [i.e. Annexure-G], Affidavit [i.e. Annexure-I], Details of Banker for Making Payment through RTGS/NEFT [i.e. Annexure-H] and Certificate from hyperlink given in clause no: 3 of Buyer added Bid Specific ATC under "Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions" and fill as per instruction given below and upload the same in website (GeM) in .pdf file (No price part should be mentioned in this document). The bidder is also requested to upload scanned copies of the same.

(1) Letter of Bid: This will be downloaded by the bidder and will be printed/ typed on his letter head as per format. This document will be signed by the bidder and submitted the same.

(2) Affidavit: Notarized affidavit of Annexure-I on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper (minimum value of Rs.10) to be uploaded by the bidder on GeM Portal (for genuineness of the information furnished on-line and authenticity of the documents produced before Tender Committee for verification in support of his eligibility).

(3) Certificate: Bidders are requested to print/ type on his letter head as per format of certificate. This document will be signed by the bidder and the scanned copy of the same will be uploaded on GeM Portal during bid submission.

(4) Annexure-H: DETAILS OF BANKER FOR MAKING PAYMENT THROUGH RTGS/NEFT is to be uploaded in website (GeM) in .pdf form as it is required for RTGS/CBS /NEFT.

viii. Firm must submit mandatory documents as mentioned in Annexure- MD (attached in GeM ATC). Bidder's offer will be rejected outrightly if offer found in short of any mandatory documents. N.B. Mandatory documents will not be sought from the bidder after bid opened. There would be no provision of seeking shortfall documents.

ix. DVC has adopted Single Envelope Bidding System for all tender except EPC, QCBS and any tenders having e-reverse auction. During the Single Stage Single Envelope bid evaluation, a comparative statement of prices for all participating bidders shall be prepared first.

The techno-commercial evaluation will then be carried out only for the L1 (Lowest Evaluated) bidder

. If the techno-commercial documents of the prospective L1 bidder are found non-compliant with the NIT requirements, the evaluation shall be taken up for the next lowest bidder (L2), and so on, until a bidder is found to be fully aligned with the QR of the NIT.

All applicable provisions of the MSME Policy, Make in India (MII) Policy, and other statutory norms of GOI shall be followed in line with the provisions of NIT.

(24) Applicable LAWS:

The contractors have to comply with all the following law, if applicable.

- a. Contractor should have to abide by all statutory acts and Laws and Regulations of respective Government.
- b. Contractor shall be responsible for compliance of all statutory obligations Under Factories Act. 1948. Contract Labour Act, Minimum wages Act, payment of Wages Act and also be responsible for payment of employee's contribution under EPF etc. The contractor is to comply the ESI act as applicable.
- c. Contractor has to obtain Labour licence from statutory body i.e., concerned office of the Regional Labour Commissioner (central) as applicable.
- d. Contractor has to obtain Labour licence from Govt. Licence authority Under contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act and the copy of the same will have to be produced.
- e. The workers deployed by contractor will be bound by regulation of Factories Act 1948. Minor and women labours shall not be engaged in this job.
- f. Xerox copies of the documents showing deposit of EPF amount to the EPF Department of Govt. Should be submitted to the controlling officer and personnel department.

(25) COMPLIANCE OF REGULATIONS (CLAUSE NO.22 OF GCC DVC):

The Vendor shall warrant that all Goods and/or services covered by this Purchase Order/ contract shall all have been produced, sold, dispatched, delivered, tested and commissioned in strict compliance with all applicable laws, regulations including industries (Development & Regulations) Act, 1951 & Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 and any amendments there under, labour agreements, Safety rules and PF compliance, working conditions and technical codes and requirement as applicable from time to time. All laws, rules and regulations required to be followed in execution of the order / contract, must be complied with.

The Vendor should execute and deliver such documents as may be needed by the Purchaser/ owner in evidence of compliance. Any liability arising out of contravention of any of the laws on executing this order shall be the sole responsibility of the Vendor and the Owner shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever.

(26). TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -

The contractor would be bound by the terms and conditions as detailed in the GeM Bid/ GeM contract and DVC General Conditions of Contract (GCC) & General terms & conditions of GeM. Bidders are requested to go through General Conditions of Contract (GCC) of DVC & General terms & conditions of GeM before submission of offers. Terms and conditions which are not specifically mentioned in the NIT and Tender Documents shall be covered by the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) of DVC & General terms & conditions of GeM.

Note:

i. The terms and conditions stipulated in STC & SLA will supersede those in GTC (General terms & conditions of GeM) and Terms & conditions stipulated in ATC will supersede those in GTC (General terms & conditions of GeM) and STC in case of any conflicting provisions.

ii. The terms and conditions mentioned in ATC & Scope of work in attachment shall prevail over GeM Bid Report if there is any contradiction.

(27) PAYMENT TO WORKERS:

Payment to the Driver/s engaged by the contractor should be made within the 7th day of the following month.

(28) Total Estimated Bid Value is excluding GST. But your quoted price must be inclusive of GST. (Very Very Important)

(29) SECURITY GATE PASS:

The contractor must arrange Photo gate pass at his own cost for his workmen from the security department and the rules and regulations related to this subject shall be binding on the contractor. As KTPS, DVC is a protected area, necessary Photo Identity Pass of the persons engaged shall be arranged by the contractor or from the In Charge KTPS, the expenditure of photograph etc. shall be borne by the contractor.

(30) WAGE SHEETS:

Contractor should maintain up to date payment register of their laborers. The contract operating authority or any other representative of the controlling officer may check the register so maintained any time and if in case it is observed that the regular payment to the labors is not made, the same would be deducted from their bills and necessary action as deemed fit would be taken against contractor. Wage sheets of workers should be submitted to the controlling officer every month with the bill.

(31) SCANNED COPIES OF ALL THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

Scanned Copies of all the required documents for meeting the qualifying criteria of the tender along with the bid documents shall have to be uploaded in GeM Portal during submission of bid on line for techno commercial evaluation and compliance thereof. Tenders will be processed on the basis of scanned copy of the documents submitted by the bidders. Hard copies of the QR related documents (Original/self-authenticated and attested by public notary) will be asked from the L1 bidder in support of the information and documents furnished by the said bidder on-line for validating and record.

(32) UNAUTHORIZED OCCUPATION/POSSESSION:

Unauthorized occupation/possession of Quarters/Shop/Plot of land of DVC will be treated as a disqualification and tender submitted/Contract awarded is liable to be rejected/cancelled, as the case may be, at any stage if the vendor or his authorized representative is found to be having such unauthorized occupation/possession.

(33) LOCAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

The contractor has to abide by the rules and regulations framed by DVC authority which may change from time to time in the interest of the project. They are to follow the duty hours as will be specified by the controlling officer during execution of contract.

(34) DISCIPLINE:

The contractor's employees should maintain proper discipline and behavior and do not cause any hindrance in execution of duties by DVC, KTPS Employees. Controlling Officer is fully empowered to ask the contractor to withdraw any worker/workers on charges of misconduct, incompetence/ negligence in discharge of duties and such worker/workers may not be deployed without his permission.

(35) UPWARD VARIATION: Any upward variation in taxes & duties beyond contract period will be borne by you. However, any decrease in this respect will have to be passed on to DVC.
