Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in case where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

In case of any documents/information submitted by bidder(s) found to be false or containing any misrepresentation of having any fraudulent declaration in it, then in such eventuality, legal action (including cancellation of contract, banning of business dealing, damages, criminal proceedings etc.) as deemed fit may be initiated by BSL against the bidder.

Risk Purchase Clause

Subject to the terms and conditions of the GEM contract, if the Seller/ Supplier neglects or fails to perform the contract by the time or times agreed upon, for any reason other than Force Majeure, the Buyer/Purchaser after having come to know of such negligence or non-performance, after giving 15 days' notice to the Seller/Supplier or any such extended period that the Seller/Supplier and Buyer/Purchaser may mutually agree, to the Seller/Supplier to rectify, shall take such action as it considers fit including but not limited to taking risk purchase for supply of the material, mitigating any losses, at the risk and cost of the Seller as far as the undelivered quantity in the Delivery Period is concerned. The Right of the Buyer for Risk Purchase Action is in addition to the Right of Buyer to terminate the contract due to the fault of the Seller/Supplier. The price differential in case of higher costs to SAIL, BSL, KIOM/MIOM if any, shall have to be borne by the defaulting Seller/Supplier. SAIL, BSL, KIOM/MIOM reserves the right to recover the price differential from pending orders of the supplier in BSL or other units of SAIL. Moreover, the defaulting Seller/Supplier have no claim over the quantity, which they are required to supply.

14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
