SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR HIRING OF VEHICLE

1. General Conditions of Contract-2018 Services is applicable with all corrections slips from time to time for this work/service. The tenderer (s) are to read carefully the Spl. Condition of hiring of vehicle & other terms and conditions attached herewith before quoting the rates.
2. Special conditions for hiring of vehicle are in addition to the General Conditions Contract-2018 services.
3. In case of any contradiction between General Conditions of Contract and Special Conditions of Contract then, the former will always prevail.
4. The tenderer(s)/firm is/are to read carefully the Special Conditions of hiring of vehicle & other terms and conditions attached herewith before quoting the rates.
5. The lump-sum monthly hiring charges includes all major/minor repairs, servicing of vehicles, cost of wear and tear, cost of uniforms of drivers and any other consumable required like fuel, lubricant etc., from time to time, drivers salary and allowances as per Government rules & labour laws, GST, all taxes, toll charges, parking charges, duties, incidental charges, all detentions charges, penalties etc. as imposed by central/state/local government bodies for running of vehicles payable by the contractor(s) including parking charges, toll tax, entry tax whenever required etc.
6. Payment will be made on the basis of lumpsum monthly hiring charges irrespective of number of kilometers travelled.
7. Vehicle provided should not be more than **02 Years** old from the date of its manufacturing date to the date of opening of Tender. The vehicle should be new one, good in condition, and not accident-prone. The vehicles provided by the contractor for hiring should comply to provisions of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988.
8. The contractor should submit the proof of ownership and details of vehicle, such as valid vehicle registration certificate, model of vehicle, maxi cab permit, fitness certificate, year of purchase, driver's name & address, license No. & permanent residential address etc. after receipt of Letter of Acceptance within fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of Letter of Acceptance and get approval by the Railways.
9. The vehicle, if required may move out of the nominated places to any place of Andhra Pradesh/Odisha/Chhattisgarh and remain for days together as per the requirement of the User (Railway Officer). During such period the vehicle is required to be stabled at a place desired by the User, may be in open space. The vehicle shall remain under the custody of the Driver only and Railway shall not bear the responsibility of any damage or loss to the vehicle.
10. Road Permit for the vehicle should have Road Permit for Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Chattisgarh states. The contractor will have to bear the cost towards road permit and toll tax or any other expenditure on account of Road permit.
11. All the parking, toll taxes are to be borne by the contractor. For this purpose necessary fast-tag to be provided a small amount of money may be kept by him with the drivers so that necessary payment may be made by the drivers at the time of need.

12. **Insurance:** Necessary Insurance of the Road vehicle is mandatory and the cost of insurance will be borne by the contractor. The coverage of insurance should be to the occupants inside the vehicle as well as third party liability.
13. The tenderer will have to pay salaries (monthly) to drivers through Bank Account.
14. Cost of Fuel will be not be reimbursed separately.
15. The vehicles normally shall be used by the Railway/kept with the Railway for 24 hours in a day and used as per the instruction of the User (Railway officer posted at Visakhapatnam or any other approved locations of Waltair Division).
16. The vehicle should be made readily available at all times with the Drivers, fuel and all necessities etc. The Railway can utilize the vehicle at any hour without any extra payment.
17. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing the required number of vehicles at any time, even at short notice. The services shall be available for 24 hours in a day. In the day of use of the vehicle, the Km of the day shall start when the Driver report with vehicle at the place nominated by the user near to his residence or office within Municipal/NAC area and for this maximum 3 Kms on each side, total 6 Kms i.e. (3 Kms for reporting duty & 3 Kms for release of the vehicle) or the actual Kms whichever is less can be borne by the user per day. If the above transit distance is more than 6 Kms, in that case the Contractor is to bear the extra Kms. No extra payment shall be made for the movement of the vehicle if taken by the Contractor or Driver for repair and any other purpose of the Contractor. In case the vehicle is stabled in the Shed/Garage/Portico or any other nominated place as advised by the user the vehicle shall remain under the custody of the Driver only and the Railway shall not bear the loss/damage to the vehicle during such period.
18. In no case, the Railways shall provide any accommodation food nor allowance of any kind to the Driver.
19. The completion period of the work is approximately **24 (Twenty-Four)** months after issue of acceptance letter. The contract can be extended by Railway Administration as per requirement. The railway however reserves the right to close the contract earlier also without assigning any reasons and without liability on Railway administration.
20. Every vehicle will be allowed with two off days per month for maintenance of vehicle which will be fixed by the officer using the vehicle.
21. Normal maintenance Kit, first-aid box, one torch light and one umbrella shall be always made available with the vehicle by the contractor.
22. Necessary alternative drivers and roster of Drivers etc. should be arranged for this purpose without any extra payment. Drivers shall have neat uniforms and shall be adequately trained and have valid Driving License. The vehicles should be maintained neat and tidy.
23. In case of the vehicle is detained out of station over night, the Railway will not provide any accommodation to the Drivers. The Contractor should account this for .
24. Income tax and surcharge as applicable will be recovered from each bill.
25. If the vehicle is out of order an alternative vehicle of good shape/condition will be temporarily made available within reasonable time by the contractor(s) to the railway failing to which a penalty of Rs. 2000/- per day will be imposed. Penalty for not providing the vehicles in time, inability in providing alternative vehicles during breakdown and subsequent inconvenience to service shall be Rs. 2000/- on each of such default upon report of the dissatisfaction by the user department/of ficer. The deduction will be made from the bill.

26. Penalties of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand) per day for non-reporting of vehicles and a penalty of Rs. 500/- per day for providing vehicles older than 2 years (during 36 Months) will be deducted from the bill of the contractor.
27. The vehicle will move as per instruction of the authorized representative of Railway posted at Visakhapatnam, and other locations, which shall be notified to the Contractor.
28. The contractor is responsible for safe running of the vehicle; Railway will not be responsible for any damage or accident to the vehicle.
29. The Railway reserves the right to increase/decrease number of vehicles in operation in any proportion/magnitude at any stage without assigning any reason on day-to-day basis and details of which should be sought in advance by the contractor from the authorized representative of the Railway.
30. In case of breakdown of the Speedometer of the vehicle, it will be assumed that the vehicle has not been operated for that period or number of days the Speedometer is under repair and no claim in this regard will be entertained from the contractor, in any form.
31. The Railway is at liberty to reject the vehicles found defective or unsuitable or not road worthy during duty time in which case the contractor will be liable for all consequence of penalty as per item No.25 above.
32. In case of public strike/bandh, Railway shall not be liable to make any payment towards retention charges for the period of absence nor will be liable for any other claim.
33. All vehicles shall be that are registered as commercial vehicles. All relevant documents pertaining to the vehicles and their drivers such as registrations, license, insurance and pollution control etc. shall be valid and current at all time conforming to Motor Vehicle Act-1988 and its up-to-date amendments.
34. The Driver's salary and other element of wage are inclusive of the rate to be quoted by the contractor and is to be borne by the contractor. He shall follow all rules and regulations of court and all labour laws should be taken care of in his contractual obligations. Railway shall have all right to inspect the documents in this regard and witness payments.
35. The agency/contractor should intimate the address with telephone/Cell Nos. to the nominated officer by Railway Administration and other users of the vehicles including the authorized representative of Railway. His nominated representative should be available round the clock to the railway for communications. In case the contractor does not have a phone/fax special courier shall be sent at the address of the contractor and for which ₹100/- shall be deducted from the contractor's bill on each such occasion.
36. The vehicle should be made readily available at all times with the Drivers, fuel and all necessities etc. The driver attached to the vehicle should be smart, well behaved, polite and well mannered and in clean clothes. Complete bio-data of the driver shall have to be submitted. The driver should be provided with mobile phones (having both incoming & outgoing facilities) by the contractor/vehicle suppliers so that they may be contacted as and when required. The driver should be fully acquainted with the roads of areas under East Coast Railway jurisdiction. In case of misbehavior/disobedience by driver his services will be discontinued and a new driver should be replaced immediately. In case of non-compliance of above, the Contractor will be liable for penalty as deemed fit by DEN or **Sr.DEN/West/WAT**, in addition to other actions as he may deem fit.
37. The contractor(s) should carry small minor modifications to the vehicles as and when required by the administration to be used in a lawful manner, for which no payment shall be made.

38. The Driver should have sufficient knowledge of roads and should not refuse to carry out the orders of the user.
39. LPG fuelled vehicles shall not be permitted.
40. No escalation of rates will be allowed in this contract under any circumstances.
41. The vehicle shall be required to run on Railway construction/maintenance sites in difficult terrain and even on Non-motorable roads to the extent of Railway's requirement.
42. On acceptance of tender, the contractor/supplier shall be advised about the user officer, specific type and numbers of vehicles by a schedule. Bills for use of the vehicles shall be preferred to the user who shall check these bills and arrange for payment as per the procedure. For all intents and purposes, the user shall be the client and shall represent the railway administration.
43. Payment of hire charges will be made after due verification of log book & necessary certification by the Railway officials after due internal checks as required. The log book shall be under the custody of the user/Railway officer.
44. No mileage will be allowed to drivers for lunch/breakfast or for drawl of lubricant/diesel etc.
45. The Driver's salary and other element of wage are inclusive of the rate to be quoted by the contractor and is to be borne by the contractor. He shall follow all rules and regulations of court and all labour laws should be taken care of in his contractual obligations. Railway shall have all right to inspect the documents in this regard and witness payments. Payment to the driver shall be responsibility of the contractor.
46. The Tenderer should issue identity cards to all Drivers incorporating the photographs and signature of the concerned Driver. The Identity Card should be under the signature of the Tenderer himself and no other authorized signature will be entertained for this purpose. The Identity Card should be countersigned by the Railway Authority and, in this context, no claim for job or any other remuneration, etc. will be admissible.
47. If any driver is not found to drive smoothly, Railway reserves the right to ask the contractor to replace the driver.
48. If the driver along with the vehicle report for duty but does not perform or refuse to perform duty then the case will be treated as unauthorized non reporting.
49. The complete responsibility for safe running of vehicle will be on the vehicle owner only Railway will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident of vehicle.
50. It is to be ensured by Tenderers/Contractor that, fuel tanks of vehicles are filled up before these are sent for duty.
51. The responsibility lies on contractor, to educate the vehicle driver to take necessary precautions while negotiating Un-manned level crossing, foot paths special restricted area etc.
52. The contractor indemnify the Railway against any or all claims which may arise under the Motor Vehicle Act or Workmen's Compensation Act, Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, Minimum Wages Act or any other act or statute having bearing over the service and engagement of Workmen, directly or indirectly for performance of work under the contract.
53. The contractor shall indemnify the Railway and its employees against any penalties as Principal employer, for any failure of the contractor to honour various Central/State Govt laws/enactments which are in operation or will be enacted in future. As such, the Contractor should always abreast the laws of the land being enacted by the Central, State & Local Self Government.
54. Any fine imposed on the contractor by RTO, Commissionerate Police or any other

er Govt. authority due to non observance of Govt. rules or any other reason (of whatsoever nature it may be), shall be paid by the contractor and no compensation on this account shall be paid by the Railway or reimbursed in any way. No liability shall be accepted by the Railway for such loss sustained by the contractor.

55. Safety fittings of vehicle like buffer for front section, head light, fog lights marker lights, indicators, horns, brakes etc. must be in good condition. Seats and rain water protection covers etc to be maintained in good condition.

56. Since the works required for providing transport for Officers of East Coast Railway, hence it should be made operational immediately after issuing of GeM contract.

Note: The mandatory documents as per Annexure-C as stipulated in ATC shall all be uploaded along with the offer. The bid shall be summarily rejected if the bidder fails to submit the mandatory documents.

Text Clause(s)

1. SCOPE OF WORK:

1.1 The contractor should provide Two Road Vehicles each for Official use of **SSE(Works) of Jagdalpur & Kirandul.**

1.2 The vehicle is necessary for attending quick restoration works in water supply issues, up-keeping of assets and deployment of manpower in urgency, besides daily maintenance works in interior areas and transporting the materials to the site by the above officers round the clock as and when required.

1.3 The vehicle is to be provided by the contractor round the clock on full time basis and should be made available any time during night hours also at a short notice of 30 minutes.

1.4 The vehicle may also require going out of Sr.DEN/West/WAT jurisdiction, as and when required, for which no extra payment will be given.

1.5 The vehicle shall be a Non-AC four wheeler MUV vehicle like Mahindra Bolero Camper, Isuzu S-Cab, TATA xenon XT etc.,. or similar with Driver, Fuel and Lubricant etc.,.

1.6 The Road vehicle should not be more than **two years old** from the date of its manufacturing date to the date of opening of Tender.

1.7 Transport category of vehicle (With Yellow Board) must only be provided.

1.8 The vehicle, if required may go out of above mentioned officer jurisdiction or office/site (over AP, Odisha and Chattishgarh states) and remain for days together as per the requirement of the User (Railway Officer). During such period the vehicle is required to be stabled at place desired by the User, may be in open space. The vehicle shall remain under the custody of the Driver only and Railway shall not bear the responsibility of any damage or loss to the vehicle.

1.9 In no such cases i.e. out of jurisdiction or office/site (over AP, Odisha and Chattisgarh states) or outside of said places or office/site, the Railways shall provide any accommodation or any kind of allowance to the Driver.

1.10 Vehicle is assigned to work normally for **SSE(W)/JDB and SSE(W)/KRDL**. For the purpose, vehicle shall have a road permit to ply in Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Chattisgarh States.
