DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

Introduction:

SECL, Kasmunda Area intends to carry out the work of **"Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display for enhancing the mines security awareness at various MTKs and Coal India Chowk of Kasmunda Project."**, District - Korba, Chhattisgarh -495454.

The offer shall be submitted on turnkey basis supply and execution and the bidder should submit the offer for the above work as mentioned in schedule of requirement as per following terms and conditions.

Bidders are requested to get well versed with the geographical and topographical conditions of the above mentioned locations before their final participation in the bid.

It may be noted that the survey (if any bidder wants to do) will be at the cost of bidder. However, the necessary coordination will be provided by SECL authorities.

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GENERAL SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

1.0) PERIOD OF CONTRACT : The period of Contract shall be one year of warranty period reckoned from the date of successful commissioning of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system.

2.0) SCOPE OF SUPPLY

2.1) The successful bidder will have to supply all the items specified in the Bill

of Materials, conforming to the technical specifications given in the Buyer Specification Document.

The bidder shall also upload the **make and model** (wherever applicable) of all materials quoted by them along with technical document/OEM Datasheet in their bid to ascertain the technical acceptability of materials quoted. **Failure to declare make and model of materials quoted and/or non-submission of technical document/OEM Datasheet may result in outright rejection of the bid.**

2.2) Bidder will have to supply installation & operation manual along with necessary driver software with licenses, if any, for the supplied devices/software whenever is required.

2.3) Bidder shall provide all patches and updates of firmware, during the entire contract period as and when released by OEMs without any additional cost to SECL.

2.4) The Bidder should not bid / supply any equipment / item that is likely to be declared end-of-sale during the entire contract period. In case of such happening, such devices should be replaced with a similar or higher model of supplied make, by the Bidder, without sacrificing the performance of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system at free of cost.

2.5) The Bidder's responsibility shall include but not limited to the supply of all items mentioned in Bill of material as per details given in Technical Specification and / or agreed upon, after final bid evaluation. Any additional material (cables, interfaces, part of the equipment, MS pole of suitable height and properly grouted for erection, etc.) not exclusively mentioned in the Buyer specification Document but required for successful installation and operation of the supplied Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system, are in the scope of the Bidder without any extra cost to SECL.

2.6) PACKING :- All equipment and materials supplied against this contract shall be suitably protected, covered in water proof packing and the packing should be strong enough to prevent damage or deterioration during transit handling and storage at the site till the time of final commissioning. The bidder shall be responsible for any loss or damage during transportation, handling and storage due to improper packing.

2.7) TRANSPORTATION & INSURANCE :- All transportation, transit insurance required for supply and commissioning of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system are to be arranged by the bidder and no extra cost shall be paid. Any damage to the material and system supplied through this contract till the handover of the system shall be the responsibility of the vendor and insurance (if any) required to mitigate the risk shall be borne by the vendor.

2.8) Splitting of Contract :- Since this is a case consolidated contract covering all aspects i.e. Supply, Installation & Commissioning, it will be considered as a single unit and there will be no splitting of the contract.

2.12) Payment terms: Payment of 80% of the price of materials supplied will be made on receipt and acceptance of materials as per Schedule of Requirements enclosed herewith. Payment of the balance 20% of the price of materials supplied along with the Charges payable for Installation & Commissioning of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system shall be paid after successful Installation & Commissioning of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system and Handing over the same to SECL.

3.0) SCOPE OF WORK DURING INSTALLATION AND WARRANTY PERIOD:

3.1) Maintenance during warranty period : The bidder is responsible for providing proper maintenance of the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system. Repair/replacement of each and every item damaged/ malfunctioned due to technical glitch, lightning/thundering during the warranty period of 01 year from the date of successful commissioning without any extra cost. However, equipment damaged due to strike/riots, accident, fire, earthquake will be exempted from this clause. An undertaking (**sealed and signed by bidder and duly notarized on bidder's letter head**), as acceptance of the above clause, is to be uploaded by the bidder at the time of bidding.

3.2) The Bidder shall be responsible for providing all materials, equipment, and services, specified or otherwise, which are required to fulfill the intent of ensuring operability, maintainability, and reliability of the complete equipment covered under this scope of work. This work shall be in compliance with all applicable standards, statutory regulations and safety requirements in force from date of award of this contract.

3.3) The bidder shall also be responsible for deputing trained/experienced personnel for installation, testing, commissioning and other services under the scope of work as per specification. All required tools, tackles, manpower/machines for climbing poles/towers/ heightened areas, wherever required for completing the work as per the specification is also the responsibility of the bidder.

3.4) Name Plates, Rating Plates, and labels :- All the equipment supplied under this contract should bear manufacturer's name, equipment name, model no, part no. and serial no. , different relevant rating and working ranges engraved in a noncorrosive material plate attached permanently to the equipment or engraved on the equipment itself. Wherever applicable, in critical equipment the brief operating instructions and drawings should be engraved /supplied along with equipment.

3.5) The installation of equipment shall be treated as completed only after its testing.

4.0) RELIABILITY :- The equipment offered must be highly reliable and field proven. The equipment supplied should operate without any deviation in quality

or degradation of system performance and all the parameters mentioned should be guaranteed over as mentioned in the required technical specifications in the **Buyer Specification Document**.

5.0) SAFETY : - The installation/service team required to undergo VTC training as per company norms. Bidder has to adopt proper safety aspect as per SECL & other industrial norms and ensure safety of their personnel and others during erection, installation, commissioning and maintenance of the system. The successful bidder shall be responsible for safety & security of the men & materials engaged in this work & all types of necessary safety precautions should be followed during execution of the work. The successful bidder will also have to arrange for all materials, safety tools, like helmet, shoes, safety belt etc. In no matter SECL shall be liable to the successful bidder or any member of the contractor's staff or any other person deputed by the successful bidder in case of injuries or death caused as a result of accidents either within or outside the working areas of SECL, Kusunda Area. SECL, Kusunda Area will not be liable in respect of any damage or compensation payable to any workmen or any other person employed by the successful bidder.

6.0) TRAINING : The bidder has to provide training to SECL team responsible for supervision of supplied Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system.

7.0) POWER SUPPLY : SECL shall provide 230 V (\pm 10%) single phase, 50 Hz, AC single power source at each location.

8.0) AVAILABILITY OF SPARES : Bidder is responsible for providing all the necessary spares for maintaining the Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system during the contract period.

9.0) SCOPE OF INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING:-

All tools, tackles, testing instruments, manpower/machine help for climbing of poles/towers/heightened areas etc. as required during execution of work shall be arranged by bidder. The bidder has to ensure timely installation, testing and commissioning as per the terms of purchase order / work order. Transportation of materials required for the work/manpower shall be arranged by the bidder at their own cost.

10.0) SITE SURVEY : The Bidder at the Bidder's own responsibility, cost & risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and make a detail survey before submitting the bid. The Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system design and system implementation should also concentrate on flexibility of future expansion and maintainability without much hassle. The cost

s of visiting the Site shall be at the Bidder's own expense. It shall be deemed that the tenderer has visited the site /area and got fully acquainted with the prevailing site conditions and fluctuations thereto whether he actually visits the site/area or not.

11.0) TAKING OVER :- The system shall be taken over by SO (E&M)/Area E&T In-Charge or authorized representative after successful completion and acceptance. The warranty of the system shall start with effect from the date of commissioning of the complete Outdoor Multi Colour SMD Fixed LED Display system from the Bidder to SECL authorized representatives.

12.0) In case of the unsatisfactory performance during the warranty period, the performance guarantee will be forfeited.

13.0) PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE :

13.1) Hence, Performance guarantee amounting to 10% of the total value of the tender valid for 18 months from the date of placement of order is required to be submitted by the bidder within the 15 days of placement of order and the same shall be released only after submission and verification of satisfactory Performance during warranty period.

14.0) POWER SUPPLY TO THE SYSTEM & DAMAGE DUE TO LIGHTNING, OVER-VOLTAGE, ETC:

Unregulated Power Supply (nominal 230 +/- 10% V AC) will be provided by SECL, Kusmunda Area at/near required locations for the installation.

However, the bidder will arrange for any additional power wiring/distribution, and for regulation/stabilization of voltage required. All such works must be technically and aesthetically sound and standard based, wherever applicable.
