Special terms and conditions-Version:1 effective from 25-07-2025 for category Water Purification System with UV (Ultra-Violet Process) or UV (Ultra-Violet Process)+UF (Ultra-Filtration Process) (V2)

1. Standard Terms & Conditions (STC) for Installation and Commissioning of Water Purification Systems - UV or UV + UF

Scope of Work - Installation & Commissioning:

This document outlines the standard installation and commissioning responsibilities for Water Purification Systems based on UV or a combination of UV and UF technologies.

1. Responsibilities of the Seller:

1. Provision of all tools, equipment, and machinery required for installation and commissioning of the system.
2. Supply of appropriate mounting hardware such as brackets, screws, washers, etc., for securing the machine at the designated location.
3. Proper, clean, and secure piping and water connections should be installed as per industry best practices.
4. Provision of inlet and outlet piping/connections within a range of 2-3 meters from the machine.
5. Execution of all necessary electrical wiring to ensure correct and safe machine operation.
6. Proper earthing of all machine components and insulation of electrical wiring to prevent electric shocks during use.
7. During scheduled service visits under Comprehensive Warranty or CMC (Comprehensive Maintenance Contract), the following activities will be performed:
 - Replacement of pre-filter free of cost during every service visit.
 - Complete cleaning of the water purification system and associated water tank (if applicable).
 - Annual free replacement of all filters, which may include (but are not limited to): RO Filters, Sand Filter, Sediment Filter, UV, UF, Pre-Carbon Filter, Post-Carbon Filter, Mineral Filter, Micron Filter, Dual Media Filter, Anti-Scaling, Alkaline Filter, Absorption Filter, etc., as applicable.

1. Responsibilities of the Buyer:

1. Facilitate access for the installation team by providing necessary gate passes to the installation site.
2. Ensure that the machine is installed at an accessible and appropriate location, suitable for both installation and future maintenance.
3. Ensure the availability of water supply inlet and outlet points within 1-2 meters of the machine.

4. Provide accessible electrical power sockets within 1-2 meters of the installation site.
1. **Notes to Sellers:**
 1. Sellers must adhere to the General Terms and Conditions (GTC) and ensure the product matches the specifications listed in the catalogue or exceeds them.
 2. A single model should not be uploaded under multiple catalogues with inconsistent or conflicting specifications.
 3. The product must comply with CML specifications, including but not limited to LPH (litres per hour) capacity. Any discrepancies may trigger action as per the IM policy.
 4. While uploading the product catalogue, sellers must include three distinct images:
 - Image 1: Isometric View of the Full Product
 - Image 2: Front View of the Full Product
 - Image 3: Left or Right Side View of the Full Product
 5. If inconsistencies are found in the uploaded/offered product, the OEM dashboard for the concerned brand may be removed, and the seller account suspended in accordance with IM policy.
1. **Notes to Buyers:**
 1. **For Procurement via BID/RA:**
 - Buyers should create bids with clearly defined values for critical (“Golden”) parameters such as:
 - Type of Water Purification Technology
 - Filtration Capacity (in LPH)
 - Inclusion and specifications of Storage Tank
 - Material and Capacity of Storage Tank (in Liters)
 - Maximum Feed Water TDS (ppm) at which rated LPH, and water quality is assured
 - Guaranteed Output Water Quality
 - Bids lacking specific selections or choosing “Any Value” for these Golden Parameters may be deemed ambiguous and can be cancelled at any time by the competent authority. The buyer will be held accountable if vague specifications lead to reduced competition or increased cost to the exchequer.
 2. Buyers are encouraged to apply comprehensive filters during BID/RA to include all qualifying options that meet or exceed technical requirements. For example, if a Semi-Automatic controller is required, options including Fully Automatic should also be selected. Failing to do so, resulting in restricted competition or higher procurement costs, shall be the buyer’s responsibility.
 3. Buyers must refer to Clause 4.xiii.(w) of the GTC. Any additional technical specifications added should not contradict GeM category standards. Contradictory specifications may render the bid invalid and subject to cancellation by competent authority.
 4. Before issuing the CRAC, the buyer/consignee must verify all technical specifications and parameters of the installed machine such as filtration capacity, machine type, etc., as per the contract.
 5. When sellers provide alternate models under the clause “Other Equivalent/Better Alternate Models Offered,” buyers must ensure that these models meet or exceed all original bid requirements before accepting them. This clause is relevant only in BID/RA-based procurement and does not apply to direct purchase or L1 procurement.
 6. Buyers may opt for an Extended Performance Bank Guarantee (EPBG) covering a period longer than the machine’s warranty, which may be invoked if warranty obligations are not met.

4. **Generic**

Manufacturer Authorization:Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

5. **Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 50 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 50% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

6. **Scope of Supply**

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods

7. **OEM**

IMPORTED PRODUCTS: In case of imported products, OEM or Authorized Seller of OEM should have a registered office in India to provide after sales service support in India. The certificate to this effect should be submitted.

8. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

9. **Certificates**

Material Test Certificate Should Be Sent Along with The Supply. The Material Will Be Checked by Buyer's Lab & the Results of the Lab will be the Sole Criteria for Acceptance of the Item.

10. **Certificates**

The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.

11. **Warranty**

Bidder / OEM has to give an undertaking that after expiry of warranty period, it will provide Comprehensive Maintenance Service for next 5 years for the offered products at the rate not more than 5 % of contract price per annum. Buyer reserves the right to enter into a CMC agreement with the Successful Bidder / OEM after expiry of the Warranty period at above mentioned rate and the payment for the CMC charges would be made Biannually after rendering of the CMC Services of the relevant CMC period. Performance Security of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if it fails to accept the CMC contract when called upon by the buyer. CMC would include cost of

CAMC of the equipment and the accessories supplied with the equipment. Scope of services must include biannual preventive maintenance, cost of spare parts and consumables which are essential for functionality of equipment, software updation (if required), training of personnel (if required), timely calibration, relocati

on of equipment.

(Upload the undertaking). The original Performance Security of contract will be returned only after submission and verification of AMC Performance Security for 3% of total CMC value valid up to CMC period plus 2 months (if there is no other claim).

12. **Warranty**

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 5 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

13. **Warranty**

Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period: After having been notified of the defects / service requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service / Rectification within 10 days time limit. If the Seller fails to complete service / rectification with defined time limit, a penalty of 0.5% of Unit Price of the product shall be charged as penalty for each week of delay from the seller. Seller can deposit the penalty with the Buyer directly else the Buyer shall have a right to recover all such penalty amount from the Performance Security (PBG). Cumulative Penalty cannot exceed more than 10% of the total contract value after which the Buyer shall have the right to get the service / rectification done from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the Seller besides forfeiture of PBG. Seller shall be liable to re-imburse the cost of such service / rectification to the Buyer.

14. **Forms of EMD and PBG**

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of

Director, NCDC

A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

15. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

- i. Valid OEM authorization certificate issued by original manufacturer (of the product offered) in the name of bidder must be submitted with the bid.
- ii. Bidders must submit original manufacturer's product catalogue/brochure for quoted model in English language with the bid. Installation, commissioning, testing and configuration which should include training and free of cost IQ, OQ and PQ (wherever applicable). Training wherever is applicable as per scope of supply is to be carried out by OEM or OEM authorised reseller.
- v. At least 3 supply orders of the same equipment, supplied to reputed health institute/hospitals (Central Government/State Government/PSU) in the last 3 years must be submitted with the bid.

- vi. A list of users with their contact details (containing minimum 3 users) and at least three satisfactory installations/satisfactory performance reports of same equipment from reputed health institute/hospitals (Central Government/State Government/PSU) must be submitted with the bid.
- vii. Downtime commitment for providing service is to be restricted to maximum period of 48 hours if the service centre is present in the city of installation and 96 hours if service centres is in the nearest metro city the site of installation.
- viii. The OEM of the product offered in the bid, must have its own service centre/OEM authorised service centre in the city of installation of equipment/nearest metro city to the site of installation or bidder should provide the undertaking for onsite service of equipment by OEM/OEM authorised service personnel. Bidder must submit complete postal address of the all/nearest service centres with contact details including email ID and Toll-Free Number (24X7) and escalation matrix (if available) along with the bid.
- ix. All electrical supplies should be operable at 230+/- 10V, 50Hz.
- x. The certifications of ISI/ISO/US-FDA/CE standard and other certifications required under the technical specification must be submitted with the bid.
- xi. The bidder must submit the undertaking that the OEM or the bidder is not blacklisted in any government institute at the time of participating in the bid. Bidder is liable for rejection if OEM or the bidder will be black listed in any government institute during the bidding process.
- xii. Make in India certificate issued by OEM regarding percentage of local content in the product offered by bidder must be submitted with the bid and will be applicable as per the make in India related order of the Government of India.
- xiii. Bid Security Declaration must be submitted by bidder (on company letterhead) with the declaration that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity or commit any other breach of tender conditions / contract which would have otherwise attracted forfeiture of EMD or fail to / refuse to initiate the execution of the awarded Contract as per the terms of the Contract etc., they will be suspended from being eligible for bidding / award of all future tender(s) for a period as applicable per the Incident Management Policy of GeM.
- xiv. Bidder must submit an undertaking with the bid that the product offered in the bid is compliant with the desired technical specifications attached at sl. no 16 (Buyer uploaded ATC) and mentioned at sl. no. 15 (Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC) under Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms & Conditions.
- xv. Failure of submission of desired certificate or report or submission of any forged or counterfeit certificate or report will disqualify the bidder without any further communications.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.

12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.

16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. Additional Clause For Comprehensive Maintenance Charges

- 1.CMC shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, after satisfactory completion of Warranty. During the CMC period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months or as per user requirement. Cost of consumables shall not be included in CMC.Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during CMC period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend CMC period by double the downtime period.
- 2.CMC charges to be indicated as percentage of cost of equipment quoted for each year after the warranty period.
- 3.GST shall be included in the CMC Charges quoted.
- 4.Cost of CMC will be added for Ranking/Evaluation purpose with depreciation formula.A 10% discounting rate per year shall be applied on CMC Charges for price evaluation on Net Present Value.

5.The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user.

6.While creating a bid or RA, buyers shall indicate whether CMC is required against Yes/No” options. If CMC Charges are included, an option for number of years for CMC required after the warranty period shall be available.Under this option up to 10 years can be chosen for CMC charges beyond warranty period.

7.In case the bid has a provision for CMC, the warranty of the product will also be deemed to have been converted into Comprehensive warranty including preventive maintenance and calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, during the Warranty Period also. Sellers are therefore advised to include the cost of Comprehensive Warranty including spares (excluding consumables) also in product Cost.

8.The CMC functionality shall be available in bid only and no direct RA shall be applicable.In case of bid to R/A decrement rules shall be applicable on total price inclusive of CMC charges. Bunching of products shall not be available while creating bids with CMC charges.

8.1.Buyer shall indicate number of years of warranty by selecting different options available in the field depending on warranty parameter applicable in category parameters for the equipment. No. of years of warranty indicated here shall supersede the warranty period indicated elsewhere in bid or product specifications. The Seller while participating in Bid/RA will get fields to indicate CMC charges as percentage depending on number of years of CMC selected by Buyer. The following shall be applicable, if 5 year CMC selected:

- CMC charges for 1st year after warranty period- Percentage to be indicated- A1
- CMC charges for 2nd year after warranty period- Percentage to be indicated- A2
- CMC charges for 3rd year after warranty period – Percentage to be indicated- A3
- CMC charges for 4th year after warranty period – Percentage to be indicated- A4
- CMC charges for 5th year after warranty period – Percentage to be indicated- A5

Similarly, A6 to A10 are to be indicated for 6th to 10th year of CMC if applicable.

8.2.The calculation of CMC Charges shall take into account the number of years of warranty and duration of CMC as specified while creating bid.

8.3.In the price evaluation, the system shall provide function to calculate the cost of each equipment by formula indicated below includingCMC and then show the inter-se-ranking of the bidders. The following are the variables

- (i) Number of years for which CMC required.
- (ii) Number of years of product warranty

The formula for calculating total cost including CMC charges shall be as under:

Total Cost for evaluation=

$C + C * \{ (A1/100)/(1.10^n) + (A2/100)/(1.10^{n+1}) + (A3/100)/(1.10^{n+2}) + (A4/100)/(1.10^{n+3}) + (A5/100)/(1.10^{n+4}) \}$ and so on

C – Cost for equipment quoted and n shall be number of years of product warranty specified.

If 2 year warranty specified, n shall be 2 and if 5 year warranty specified, n shall be 5. A1,A2, A3, A4& A5shall depend on how many years CMC selected. For 3 year CMC, only A1,A2 and A3 factors are to be taken into account and A4 and A5 will not be applicable.

8.4.CMC charges offered for each subsequent year should be same or higher than preceding year.

8.5.The CMC charges shall be offered within range of 3 to 25% of cost of equipment.

9.Since CMC charges are to be paid only later for each year during CMC period,applicable performance guarantee amount after placement of contract shall be based on the cost of equipment excluding the cost of CMC Charges.

10.Performance bank guarantee applicable for CMC is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable between 2.5% to 10% as specified in bid on total CMC Charges.The PBG submitted after award of contract shall be released only after new PBG for the CMC period is submitted and accepted by buyer/consignee after due verification.Bank guarantee for CMC is to remain valid till completion of CMC period plus one year. The bank guarantee for CMC shall be submitted to buyer directly. In case, seller fails to submit the PBG or does not provide services for the CMC contract after expiry of warranty period then PBG of equipment shall be forfeited.

11.In case of splitting of order quantity, equipment cost and CMC charges offered by L1 bidder shall be matched by higher quoting eligible bidders on one-to-one basis.The equipment cost and CMC charges (year to year) shall be matched individually.

12.The CMC Contract shall be an offline contract to be handled by buyer.The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user and scope of CMC will be as per para 1 above.

13.CMC Charges are inclusive of all the charges for Transportation, Lodging, Boarding, all insurances including third party insurance and all other incidental charges. The same shall include GST. The prices also include cost of spares and damaged parts. Purchaser does not have any liability, whatsoever, over and above the cost of CMC. It also includes for arranging hand tools & tackles, special tools etc. required to carry out the work.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.
