Techno-Commercial offer should be prepared by bidder on their company letter head, which complies/contains all the Technical specifications & Commercial conditions mention in our NIT and Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions, failing which your offer shall be liable for rejection.

Mode of Tendering:

PROPRIETARY tender basis through customized bid.

Authorized dealer/distributor can participate with bid specific OEM authorization.

ATC:

- 1) Bidder shall clearly mention the Confirmation to the Technical Specification (Refer to Specification document under Technical Specifications) & other conditions as given in the NIT and Buyer added ATC in their offer.
- 2) Vendor should submit bid only if tender additional terms & conditions and GEM general terms & conditions (GTC) are acceptable. Any commercial term mentioned as an attachment shall be ignored.
- 3) Prices on GeM are inclusive of all cost component i.e. GST, freight, P&F, insurance, any other charges applicable by GEM etc. Any other condition mentioned anywhere in the attachment shall be ignored.

1 set price shall be the summation of all the items prices multiplied by the respective quantities. Bidder should mandatorily quote for all items.

- 4) Bidders should refer our NIT (Refer to Specification document under Technical Specifications) item long text for detailed specification to quote their price.

- 5) **Payment term:** 90% after receipt and acceptance and balance 10% after expiry of warranty period.

Payment of GST is subject to the reflection of invoice in GSTR-2A/Anx-2 (GST New Return) of NALCO.

- 6) **Bank Guarantee:** Any Bank Guarantee (EMD, Performance etc) that the bidder is required to submit must follow NALCO's format. The bidder must request the format if not attached in NIT.

- 7) **Warranty** - The products shall be warranted towards manufacturing defects for a period of 12 months from the date of installation or 18 months from the date of receipt whichever is earlier. However, the Party will have to replace in case of any premature failure. Any damage due to faulty running of belt or foreign material causing damage to the product is not covered in this guarantee.

- 9) Indicate whether you are registered under MSME vendor category (Please provide certificate).

- 10) **Liquidity Damage (LD)** - Delivery period is the essence of the contract and the materials should be dispatched within this time, failing which, NALCO without prejudice to its rights under the contract shall have the option either to recover liquidated damages @ 1/2% of order value per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 5% of the undelivered portion/ the order value (if the item(s) cannot be used unless full supply is made) or to cancel the Order and purchase the materials from alternative source at the risk and cost of the supplier.

- 11) NALCO is a SA8000 certified company and all bidders interested to supply material to NALCO should be committed to social accountability. Hence, please submit the completely filled SA8000 questionnaire provided with the tender (without any alteration to the format) along with the offer. SA8000 certified companies can submit their certification. Non-compliance to the requirements of SA8000 may lead to rejection of the

offer.

12) TDS under section 194Q:

a) Finance Act 2021 has brought amendments in existing TDS/TCS Sections and has introduced new Sections 194Q (Deduction of tax at Source on payment of certain sum for purchase of goods) and 206AB (Special provision for deduction of tax at source for non-filers of income-tax return) among others. The above Sections would be effective from 01st July, 2021.

b) NALCO, being Buyer (under Section 194Q inserted in the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide Finance Act 2021) having total sales, gross receipts, or turnover from business above Rupees Ten Crores during the last Financial Year, will deduct TDS under Section 194Q, w.e.f. 01.07.2021, at the prescribed rate of 0.1% on the purchase value of any goods, aggregate of which is exceeding the threshold limit of Rs.50 Lakhs in a Financial year.

c) Accordingly, Vendors/Sellers are not to collect tax at source under section 206C(1H) of the Act w.e.f. 01.07.2021, in case provisions of section are applicable to them.

d) The above is as per the current statute and is subject to modification(s) based on amendments/notifications under Income Tax Act, 1961, from time to time. Income Tax TDS, as applicable at the prevailing rate on the gross amount billed shall be deducted from the contractor's bills.

e) Vendor/Party categorized/designated as "specified person" under Section 206AB of Income Tax Act, 1961 shall be liable for TDS at higher rate as provided under the said section, by NALCO. So, Vendors/Contractors are advised to submit self-certified copies of Income Tax return (ITR) for each of the Two Previous Years for which due date for filing of **ITR** has expired, along with the Invoice/Bill so as to facilitate NALCO, verify the applicability of Section 206AB.

13) In case of order placement, vendor shall comply to "EHS (Environment Health & Safety) GUIDELINES TO SUPPLIERS" provided with the tender.

14) "No communication shall be entertained outside GeM regarding the subject tender. Representation if any for clarification against this tender may be raised on GeM only."

15) If applicable, the EMD can be submitted either in the form of i). Bank Guarantee (including e-Bank Guarantee) from banks acceptable to NALCO as per format of NALCO, valid for 30 days beyond the required validity of bid. ii). In the form of TT remittance/ online transfer - NEFT, RTGS, SWIFT. iii). Account payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque, etc. from a Commercial Bank.

Bids without EMD (wherever asked) shall not be considered. However, in exceptional cases, where no. of techno-commercially acceptable bids is less than three, the bidders who have not submitted EMD may be asked to submit EMD before price bid opening giving suitable time limit. Bidders claiming exemption from submission of EMD must ensure their eligibility as per NIT terms. Any bid rejected for non-submission of EMD due to ineligibility for exemption shall be at the bidder's own risk.

The EMD will be returned to all unsuccessful bidders within seven working days after finalization of the order. The EMD of the successful bidder will be returned after they accept the order, submit Security Deposit (SD) or Contract cum Performance Bank Guarantee (CPBG) and bank confirmation of the SD/CPBG thereafter, as the case may be. In case where submission of SD/CPBG is not a condition of tender, EMD of successful bidder will be released after successful execution of the order. In case where submission of SD/CPBG is a condition of Purchase Order and if the successful bidder accepts the order but fails to submit the Security Deposit/ Contract cum Performance Bank Guarantee, the EMD will be retained. In such cases the differential amount towards SD/CPBG and EMD may be deducted from the bills of vendor which may be released after receipt of SD/ CPBG. In the event of non-execution of order, the EMD shall stand forfeited.

16) The tendered quantity does not include weight of packaging materials. Hence, the invoiced quantity should

d exclude packaging weight if any.

- 17) The weight at receipt end (NALCO weighbridge) is final for payment. The final payment shall be based on receipt quantity or invoice quantity whichever is less.
- 18) The bidder shall ensure submission of complete information / documents in the first instant itself. NALCO reserves the right to evaluate the offer based on the details furnished by the bidders on the scheduled date of tender submission without seeking any subsequent additional information. If at all shortfall documents are sought from the bidders, bidders are required to submit shortfall documents only pertaining to the technical credentials already submitted in the first instant, any fresh supply experience credentials (e.g. Purchase orders/ completion certificates) will not be considered for evaluation of the bids.

As per Manual for Procurement of Goods, Second Edition, 2024 Ministry of Finance Department of Expenditure 7.3.5, The Procuring Entity reserves its right to, but without any obligation to do so, seek any shortfall information/ documents only in case of historical documents that pre-existed at the time of the Bid Opening, and which have not undergone change since then and does not grant any undue advantage to any bidder. As far as the submission of documents is concerned regarding qualification criteria, after submission of the bid, only related shortfall documents should be asked for and considered. For example, if the bidder has submitted a supply order without its completion/performance certificate, the certificate can be asked for and considered. However, no new supply order should be asked for to qualify the bidder. No post-bid clarification at the initiative of the bidder shall be entertained. Hence bidders are required to take due care to upload all relevant work credentials available with them in order to avoid rejection
